DESCRIPTION

Now in its Sixth year, Week of Welcome, affectionately known as WOW, has become an important tradition at the University of Vermont for both incoming First Year students and returning Upperclassmen. The WOW Squad is a group of energetic students who serve as guides, hosts, and friendly faces to incoming first-year students (as well as our returning students) during the first week of school. There will be a number of fun events for the WOW Squad to facilitate, from coffee days to BBQs to music and movie events. The WOW Squad will serve as the production crew to make this happen.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT

WOW Squad members must commit to Week of Welcome 2008 from Wednesday, August 27 through Saturday, September 6. This includes two days of training, and move-in day for First Year students. WOW officially starts on the first day of classes (Tuesday, September 1) and continues through Saturday of that week. WOW Squad members must be willing to work at approx. half of the WOW events.

DUTIES

- Work closely with WOW Coordinator, Student Leader(s), and other staff to produce and staff the Week of Welcome events. Each staff member will be expected to work approximately half of the events. And you must be able to work evenings.
- Serve as a friendly resource for other students during WOW events.

COMPENSATION

- Stipend of \$300 for August 27 – September 6, 2008.
- Free meals during training and while working. Free t-shirts and other fun stuff!
- Early move-in (to on campus housing).
- An awesome experience

REQUIREMENTS

- Current UVM Student, in good academic and judicial standing.
- WOW Squad must commit to the Week of Welcome program from Wednesday, August 27 through Saturday, September 6. WOW Squad should not have any major commitments (other than classes) during this time. Please contact us with questions about specific circumstances.
