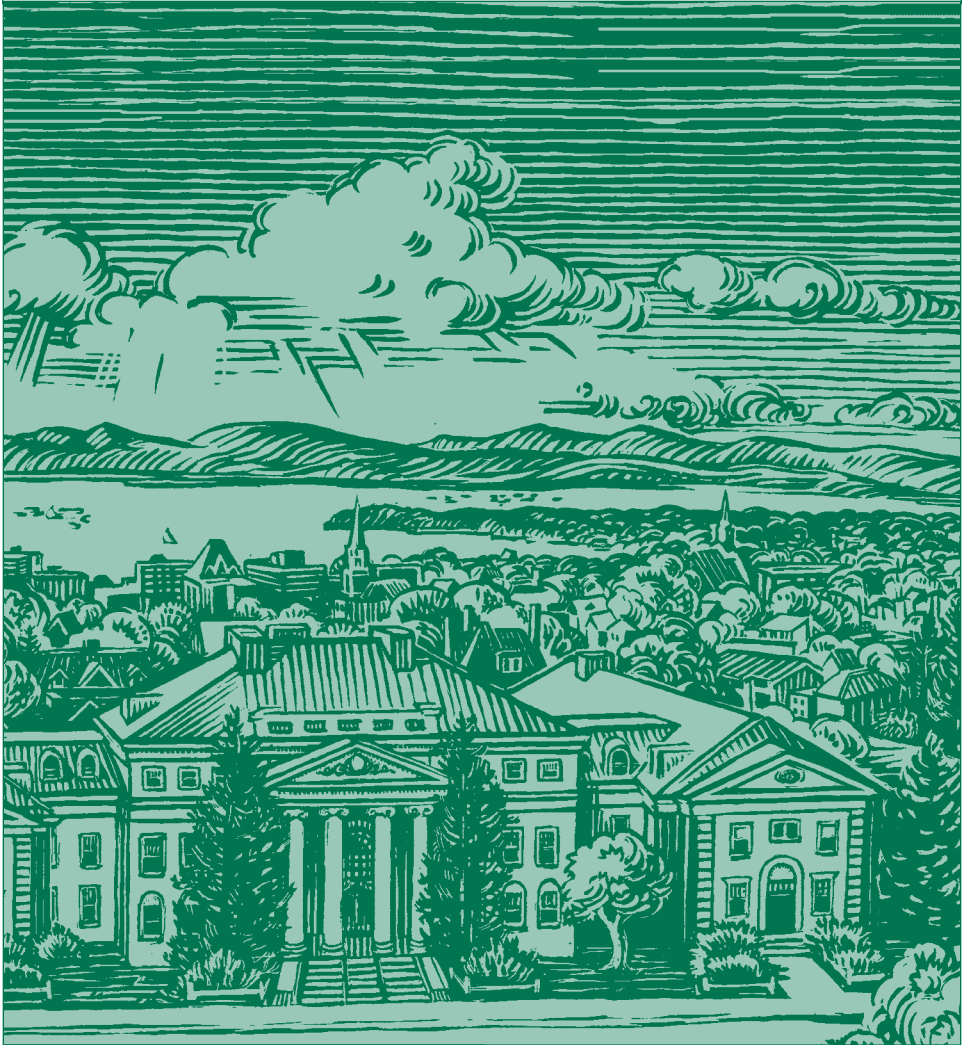

ATTEND AN ADMITTED STUDENT VISIT DAY

We invite you and your family to spend a day on campus exploring life as a University of Vermont student. Our Admitted Student Visit Day program includes:

- Presentations by the UVM school or college to which you've been admitted.
- Information sessions with faculty and staff from many academic and student activities areas.
- A student panel offering insight into life at UVM.
- Campus and facilities tours (includes residence halls).

WHERE TO STAY

When we receive your reservation, we'll send you more detailed program information and a list of local lodging options. Program check-in is held at the Sheraton Hotel and Conference Center, which offers discounted rates for reservations made three weeks in advance by families attending our programs. Call the Sheraton at (802) 865-6600 to reserve a room; specify that you're attending a UVM Admitted Student Visit Day. By May 1

COMPLETE YOUR ENROLLMENT AT UVM

Pay the \$450 acceptance fee. Options:

- Pay online (*preferred*) by e-check or credit card (Mastercard, American Express, Discover, or VISA). Visit www.uvm.edu/admitted for enrollment details.
- Send a check or money order payable to the University of Vermont with the enclosed card and envelope. (Cash not accepted)

Please note VISA is not an option for paying tuition and other billed charges.

Payments made or postmarked after May 1 will be considered on a space-available basis. The acceptance fee is a one-time fee separate from tuition; it is not a tuition deposit.

Notify any other colleges to which you've been accepted that you plan to attend the University of Vermont.

Deadline extensions are granted only if you have applied for need-based financial aid and have not received your financial aid package within *three working days* of the deadline. Please email the Office of Admissions at admissions@uvm.edu before the payment deadline to request an extension.

If your plans to enroll change before May 1, you may request a full refund of the acceptance fee. After May 1, the acceptance fee is non-refundable. Withdrawals may be made in writing by email to the Office of Admissions at admissions@uvm.edu.

In June

ATTEND NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

All new students are required to attend June Orientation, a two-day session that will answer many of your questions about preparing for your first year at UVM. You'll meet with an academic advisor, register for classes, tour residence halls, and list your preferences for housing. We invite your family to attend as well; special programming focuses on their concerns.

Depending on your major, you will have a choice of program dates. Orientation registration information arrives after the acceptance fee has been paid. Visit www.uvm.edu/studentlife/orientation for additional details about the program.

Currently enrolled high school students, please request that your final high school transcript confirming your graduation date be sent to the UVM Office of Admissions.

In August

MOVE TO CAMPUS AND START CLASSES

You'll move to campus the Friday before classes begin. During Opening Weekend, staff and current students offer programs designed to help you get to know your classmates and engage you in campus life. This required weekend program includes information sessions, recreational and social opportunities, as well as discussion groups on academic life, cultural diversity, personal health and safety, using university resources, and understanding policies.
