

Lattie F. Coor Graduate Fellowships in the Humanities

The Lattie F. Coor Endowment in Support of Teaching and Research in the Humanities funds two merit-based graduate student fellowships each year at \$5,000 apiece. Duration: one year for second-year students; two years for first-year students.

Eligibility: Applicants must be first- or second-year students in a Humanities Graduate Program. Priority will be given to full-time students, although part-time students may be considered. Applicants may not concurrently hold a Graduate Teaching Assistantship. Deadline for applications is March 15.

Application materials:

1. For incoming (first-year) graduate students:
 - A copy of the student's graduate college application
 - A letter of recommendation from the Graduate Coordinator of the UVM Humanities department to which the student is applying.

2. For second-year or continuing graduate students:
 - Cover letter describing your current status and degree program and outlining your scholarly interests and career plans. Please include your GRE scores in the letter. [Note that you do not need to send us an official report.]
 - Curriculum vitae
 - Copy of transcript from your previous year of graduate study
 - A letter of recommendation from a University of Vermont faculty member who knows your academic work in your graduate program.

Send applications to the Associate Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences. Selection will be made by chairs of Humanities Departments with graduate programs.
