Hearing Aid Program

Benefiting University Faculty, Staff and Their Dependents

The Eleanor M. Luse Center Audiology Clinic, part of the Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders, is offering a benefit for hearing aid costs to UVM staff, faculty, retirees and their dependents. This is a 10% reduction in the retail cost of hearing aids that are selected and fit through the Eleanor M. Luse Center Audiology Clinic. All professional fees (hearing evaluation, hearing aid selection, functional communication assessment, earmolds, fitting and follow-up) normally applied will be in effect.

Savings range from **\$60** to **\$220** per instrument, depending on the hearing aid determined to be the best fit for your hearing loss and listening needs.

We will work with best practice and care protocols to ensure you receive the maximum benefit. As always, we will continue to select instruments that are smartly designed, feature advanced technology and are highly durable. The 45-day return period (this is Vermont law and enforced whenever and wherever hearing aids are provided inside the state) and all warranties will apply as usual.

To qualify for the benefit, the individual seeking a fitting must be enrolled in UVM insurance (BCBS).
