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Mycotoxin quick tests are now available from the UVM Cereal Grain Testing Laboratory.
Samples will be accepted on the 2nd Wednesday of every month (10/12, 11/9, 12/14, etc.).
This allows for efficient use of labor and supplies to keep test costs at a minimum.

Please submit one **Sample Submission Form** with each properly labeled sample to be analyzed.

Submit with 1 gallon of refrigerated or frozen sample.

Levels of DON will be reported in ppm; all other tests (Aflatoxin, Fumonisin, T-2, and Zearalenone) will be reported as a presence or absence of the mycotoxins. If results indicate a presence, we will provide suggestions for further quantitative analysis.

Results will be provided within 10-14 business days upon receipt of sample(s).
