

Governor's Institutes of Vermont Weekend Institute Information 2007

A Focus On Global Climate Change: What You Can Do!

TO ALL WEEKEND STUDENTS: We look forward to seeing you soon at our 10th Governor's Institutes Weekend. Here is a map of Goddard College in Plainfield, VT and some important details.

Parking: Enter first driveway to Goddard College coming from Route 2. Drive past the first (upper) parking lot and drive down to the second (lower) parking lot, which is closer to the Haybarn Theater.

Registration: Friday, February 2, 2007 from 4:00 – 5:00 p.m. in Haybarn Theater - location will be marked with signs. Close to lower parking lot.

Closing Presentations will be Sunday from 1:30 - 3:00 p.m. in Haybarn Theater.

Leaving: Sunday, February 4 at 3:00 p.m. in Haybarn Theater for all students, just following Closing Presentations.

Families and friends are invited to join with the Weekend students at the Closing Presentations on Sunday.

Money: You must pay in full before registration. \$149 covers room, meals, and all program costs. Financial aid available. Please ask us for details.

Bedding: Linens are provided. Towel is provided also.

Room Key: We encourage you to bring nothing valuable and hope you won't need keys, but keys are available if you wish. There is no deposit, but you will be charged \$10 if you do not return the key on Sunday.

Student Contract: Please sign the enclosed Student Contract and **bring with you to registration.**

Cars: If you drive, you will park your car in the lower parking lot adjacent to Haybarn Theater and you will hand in your keys at registration. They will be returned to you on Sunday afternoon.

Food: The food, prepared by New England Culinary students, is way above average college food. There is no snack bar and no vending machines, so plan ahead and bring some snacks with you if you need to eat frequently.

Health: Please make sure you speak to staff at registration about all medications. You must agree and acknowledge that a condition of participation is that we cannot be held liable for any consequences or problems that may arise with any health problems or medication. Directions: Take Route 2 from Montpelier - or from St. Johnsbury - to Plainfield Village. Turn on to Route 214 and take first left at sign for Goddard College.
