

Teacher's Oath

Title 16, Section 12 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated requires that every professor, instructor or teacher employed by a university or college in the State which is supported in whole or in part by public funds shall subscribe to an oath or affirmation to support the constitution of the United States of America, the constitution of the State of Vermont, and the laws of the United States and the State of Vermont.

For your convenience you will find at the bottom a formal statement of the oath with a place for your signature and the signature of a Notary Public.

You should return the notarized oath along with your letter of acceptance.
