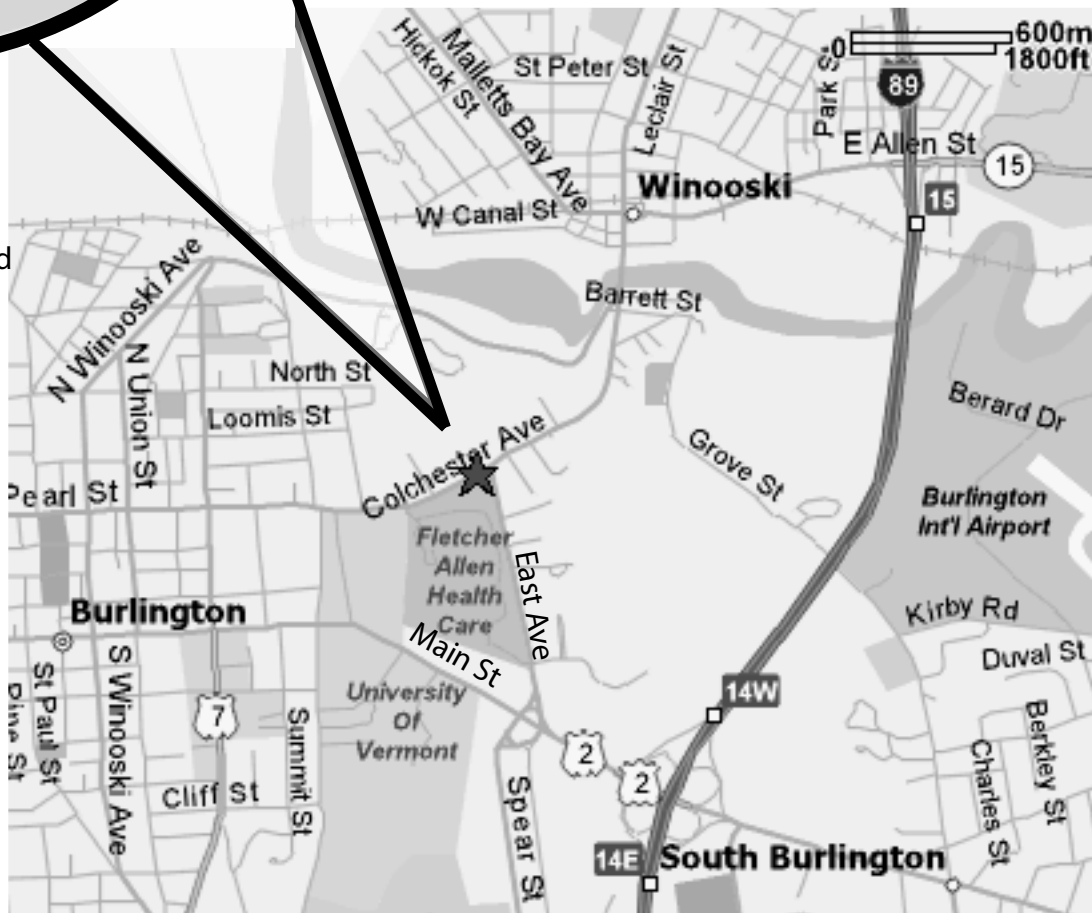
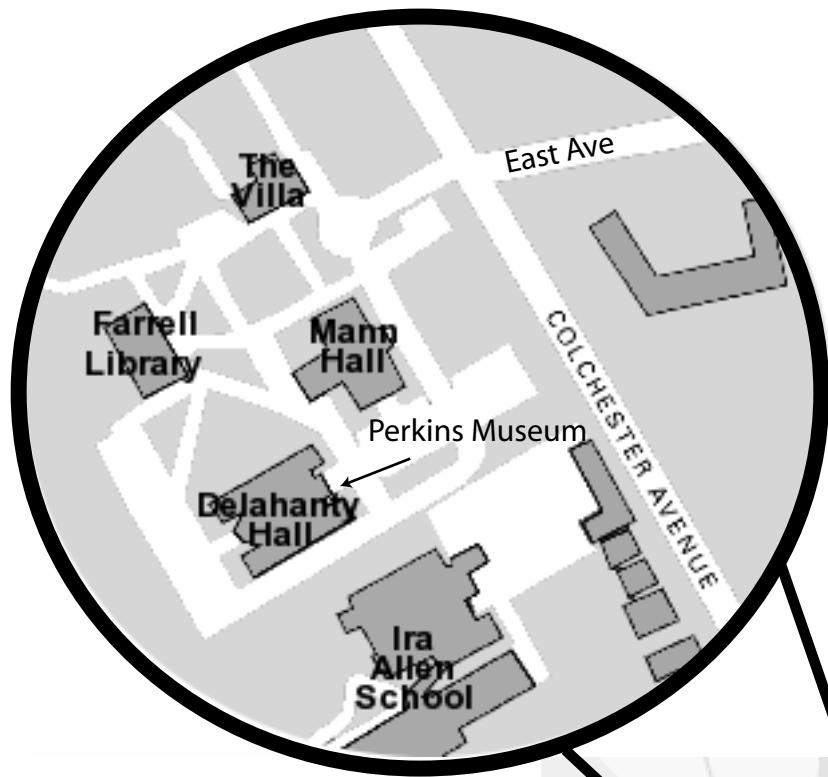


Perkins Museum of Geology
