Smoking

Policy Statement

The University of Vermont, in order to maintain a safe and healthful atmosphere and to remain in compliance with fire and safety regulations, is a non-smoking institution. No smoking is allowed within the University vehicles and University buildings, including residence halls. Smoking is permitted outdoors on University property, in areas more than 25 feet away from building entrances, operable windows and air intakes, with the exception of areas where safety, health, or pedestrian traffic flow are overriding considerations.
