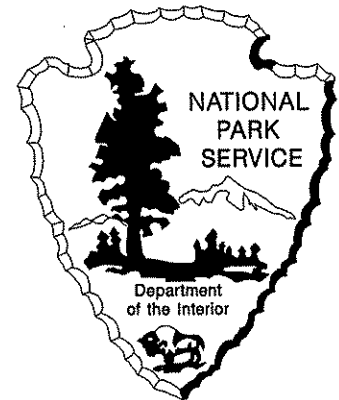

#### **ABOUT THE PARK:**

The Marsh-Billings-Rockefeller National Historical Park (NHP) is the first unit of the National Park Service to focus on the theme of conservation history and the evolving nature of land stewardship in America. **For further information, please visit our web site at [www.nps.gov/mabi](http://www.nps.gov/mabi)**

#### **DUTIES:**

Assists in the division of visitor services. Staffs information desks, processes reservations, operates radios and telephones, patrols park roads and trails, and provides general visitor assistance. Depending on length of availability may research, develop and present guided interpretive tours throughout the 550 acre park.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

For GS-0025-04, 6 months of general experience and 6 months of specialized experience, that demonstrates the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to do the job duties OR 2 years of college (60 semester hours with 12 semester hours of natural sciences, social sciences, park and recreation management, and other disciplines related to management and protection of park resources, both natural and cultural) or a combination thereof.

#### **UNIFORMS:**

Selected candidates will be required to wear the official National Park Service uniform; specific requirements and ordering information are contained in the employment package forwarded to successful applicants. An allowance is allotted which partially covers the cost of the uniform components.

#### **HOUSING:**

Housing is provided by the park, located several miles away so a car is necessary. There is a monthly rental fee.

#### **HOW TO APPLY:**

College students are eligible to be considered for Seasonal Park Ranger/Summer Intern positions under the Federal "Student Temporary" hiring authority. Interested candidates should mail an up-to-date Resume **OR** optional Application for Federal Employment, form number OF-612 (form can be electronically downloaded from [HTTP://WWW.USAjobs.OPM.GOV](http://WWW.USAjobs.OPM.GOV)) along with an official college transcript.
