Public Forum

- o UVM President Tom Sullivan
 - Meets regularly with all the Vice Presidents, meets with the Deans of colleges regularly, and has other big group discussions.
 - Spends about 50% of time on Alumni relations and fundraising. The other 50% is on the 4 principle goals: affordability, elevate the quality of the university, build and maintain infrastructure, lead and manage the university in the most effective and efficient way.
 - Since being here: lowest increase in tuition over the last 40 years, \$400 million of new infrastructure (recognized 14 buildings on campus that need to be modernized), added at least 20 new majors and minors, and investments into academic programs.
 - The Taft Building: Getting renovated for the arts. Will be the home of the Integrated Creative Arts on campus.
 - Was a lawyer in Washington D.C. and New York City, then became a professor at 2 universities, then became the dean of the Law School at the University of Arizona, then became the provost at the University of Arizona, and then became the President of UVM.
 - (In regards to the recent cuts to the Music Department) The decisions on the budget are very decentralized, the colleges within UVM deal with the entire budget pertaining to that college.
 - Talking with third party developers to build more apartments around the campus to help with the off-campus housing issue.
 - Attempting to buy a piece of property off of Spear St.
