**Resolution Congratulating Chief Lianne Tuomey on becoming UVM's First
Female Chief of Police**

WHEREAS, in May of last year, President Fogel in his closing address to the Board of Trustees, announced that Lianne Tuomey would take over as the new Chief of UVM Police from then Police Chief Gary Margolis as requested by Chief Margolis and the Fogel Administration,

WHEREAS, Lianne Tuomey made UVM history when President Fogel announced that she would be taking over as chief marking the first time in history that a female was named Chief of UVM Police,
