I have installed an exhibit of photographs introducing people of Puerto Cabezas, Burlington's sister city on Nicaragua's Caribbean Coast.

When Burlington became connected with its sister city in 1984 we discovered a region populated predominantly by indigenous Miskito and Afro-descendant Creole people whose languages and cultures differed vastly from the Spanish-influenced Pacific side of Nicaragua.

My photographs, made over 30 years, have been a way of getting to know the region, meeting people in everyday locations where they gather, and seeking out musicians, artists and poets whose works provide valuable insights into sense of place.

Some of the prints in the exhibit are augmented with qr codes, allowing viewers to access short video clips of subjects in the photographs.

The exhibit is at the **FLYNNDOG gallery**, on Flynn Avenue in Burlington, January 5-February 26.

A gala opening reception is scheduled for Friday, January 22nd, 5:30-8 PM.
