Re: Call for Nominations: Members At-Large of the Faculty Senate

The University of Vermont Faculty Senate is seeking nominations for two (2) Members At-Large of the Faculty Senate. These 2-year terms will take effect on July 1, 2017 and end on June 30, 2019.

Nominations will be accepted from the floor of the Faculty Senate meeting on Monday, April 24, 2017, 4:00 – 5:30 p.m. in Waterman Memorial Lounge. Self-nominations are encouraged. Nominations may also be sent via email to the Senate office (Faculty.Senate@uvm.edu) prior to the April 24th meeting. The election will be held by electronic ballot, distributed via email to all eligible faculty members, by the end of April.

Eligibility to serve as Faculty Senate Member At-Large

Nominees for these positions must be elected Faculty Senators. A list of current elected Senators is available on the Faculty Senate website.

Duties of the Faculty Senate Member At-Large

Members At-Large are essential, as they serve as the voice of elected Senators at the Executive Council meetings. These members are therefore required to attend Faculty Senate Executive Council meetings regularly, in addition to the Faculty Senate meetings. Both Senate and

Executive Council meetings are held monthly on Mondays from 4:00 - 5:30 p.m. The duties of the Faculty Senate Members At-Large are outlined in the Faculty Senate Constitution and Bylaws. The full document is available on the Faculty Senate website (http://www.uvm.edu/faculty_senate).
