Re: Call for Nominations: Vice President of the Faculty Senate

The University of Vermont Faculty Senate is seeking nominations for Vice President of the Faculty Senate. The 2-year term will take effect on July 1, 2017 and end on June 30, 2019.

Nominations will be accepted from the floor of the Faculty Senate meeting on Monday, April 24, 2017, 4:00 – 5:30 p.m. in Waterman Memorial Lounge. Self-nominations are encouraged. Nominations may also be sent via email to the Senate office (Faculty.Senate@uvm.edu) prior to the April 24th meeting. The election will be held by electronic ballot, distributed via email to all eligible faculty members, by the end of April.

Eligibility to serve as Faculty Senate Vice President

UVM faculty members holding a primary appointment as an Officer of Instruction, Officer of Research, Officer of Extension, or Officer of the Libraries at the rank of Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, Instructor, or Lecturer, with a full-time equivalent of at least 0.10 are eligible. The Vice President is a member of the Faculty Senate without vote and may not also serve concurrently as an Elected Senator.

Duties of the Faculty Senate Vice President

The Faculty Senate Vice President performs the duties of the President when the latter is prevented from doing so, and is an ex officio (nonvoting) member of all Senate committees. The Vice President is a member of the Faculty Senate without vote and may not also serve concurrently as an Elected Senator. The Vice President is a voting member of the Faculty Senate Executive Council, and shall serve as Chair of the Executive Council in the absence of the President. The Vice President is a nonvoting faculty representative to the Board of Trustees on the Educational Policy and Institutional Resources Committee. The duties of the Faculty Senate Vice President are outlined in the Faculty Senate Constitution and Bylaws.
