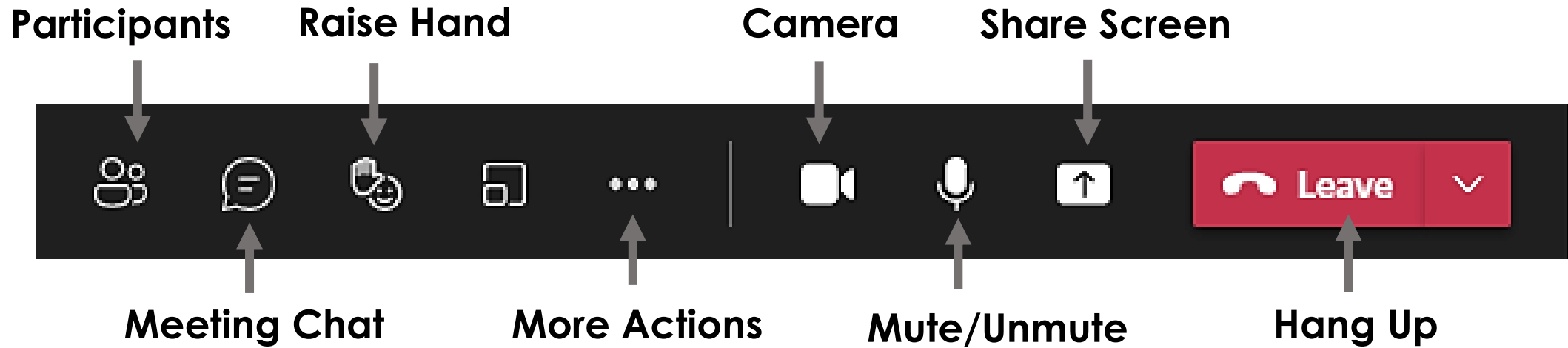

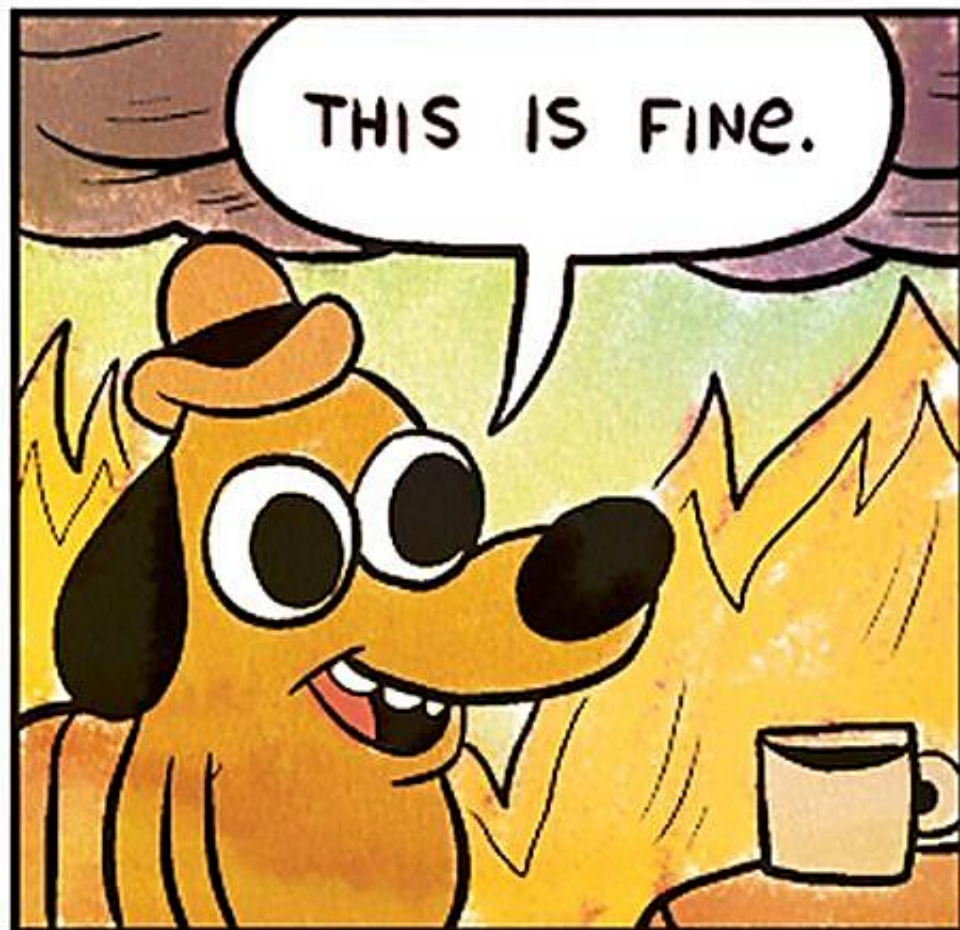

# First Semester Schedule

**12-credits** is the minimum number of credits to be **full-time**

# Mathematics Readiness Test (MRT)

- A test of basic high school math skills, including algebra and trigonometry
- All new first-year students must take the MRT **at least 48 hrs before their one-on-one advising meeting**, or risk being dropped from MATH 019
- The MRT is on your New Student Checklist and info has been sent to your UVM email

Please note: If you plan to transfer in AP Calculus credit, you are still required to complete the MRT
