SC LEADERSHIP WITH SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE PRESIDENT

On September 13, 2023, Monika, Jennifer, and Alan met with Jonathan D'Amore, Special Assistant to the President

- Successes and possible improvement to the appreciation BBQ and appreciation week.
- One UVM vision theme was covered in that we are all here for the success of UVM regardless of organization
- Space availability and conditions were discussed here as well as with HR. Concerns about job offers being turned down once the workspace is known. Administration is very aware of some of the better-known limitations. There is constant examination to better improve space usage.
