Instructions for all students:

- Your objective scores cannot decrease; there is no penalty if you attempt a problem and don't do well.

Instructions for undergraduate students:

• You may solve as many or as few problems as you wish on the Redo Homework to improve your objective scores. You are encouraged to solve all of the new problems.

Instructions for graduate students:

- You are required to turn in an attempt on every new problem of the Redo Homework. An attempt means spending at least 30 minutes thinking about a problem, and submitting the definitions and theorems you believe are pertinent to this problem, and any thought you had about the problem, whether or not they lead anywhere.
- You may solve as many or as few of the repeat problems as you wish on the Redo Homework to improve your objective scores.
