Information About Total # of Required Credits for the Certificate in Ecological Economics

The UVM Graduate School offers a number of certificate programs and only requires a maximum of 15 credits (5 courses) for completion of any one certificate. However, individual departments at UVM may choose to include additional courses in their certificate program requirements. This is done in order to tailor different certificate programs according to each department's program goals. At the Gund Institute, the *Certificate in Ecological Economics* requires completion of a total of 21 credits (7 courses) over a consecutive five-year period.
