## Information About Total # of Required Credits for the Certificate in Ecological Economics

The UVM Graduate School offers a number of certificate programs and only requires a maximum of 15 credits (5 courses) for completion of any one certificate. However, individual departments at UVM may choose to include additional courses in their certificate program requirements. This is done in order to tailor different certificate programs according to each department's program goals. At the Gund Institute, the *Certificate in Ecological Economics* requires completion of a total of 21 credits (7 courses) over a consecutive five-year period. This has been approved by the UVM Graduate School.

**Reminder:** You may transfer up to six graduate credits (two classes) toward the required Core Competencies, from UVM or any other accredited school. If a student chooses to do this and the courses are approved, then the total number of required credits for completion of this certificate is reduced to 15 credits.
