Note B: Make an affirmative entry by slanting a line (Thus /) in one of the three columns 2, 3, and 4, according as the fact is in the case of each farm, in column 2 if the occupier is the owner of the farm, in column 3 if he is the tenant on a fixed money rental, in column 4 if he conducts it for a share of the product.

Note C: Enumerators will observe that there are 100 questions relating to each farm, which are arranged in four successive divisions of each schedule page.
