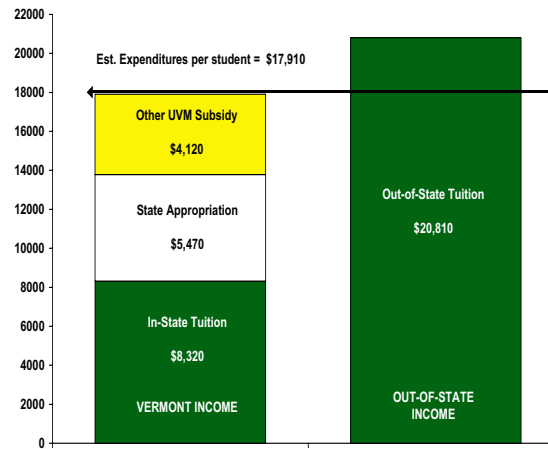

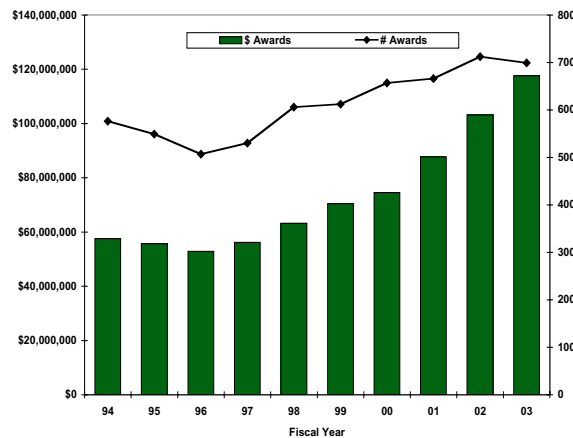

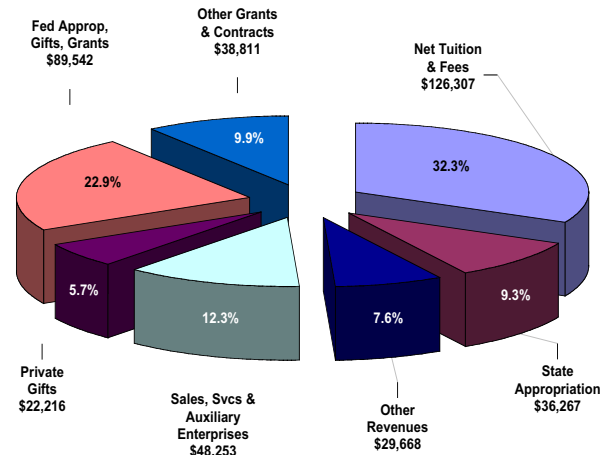
Sponsored Program Awards, FY 1994- FY 2003

In FY 2003, UVM was granted 699 sponsored program awards, resulting in a record \$117.5 million.

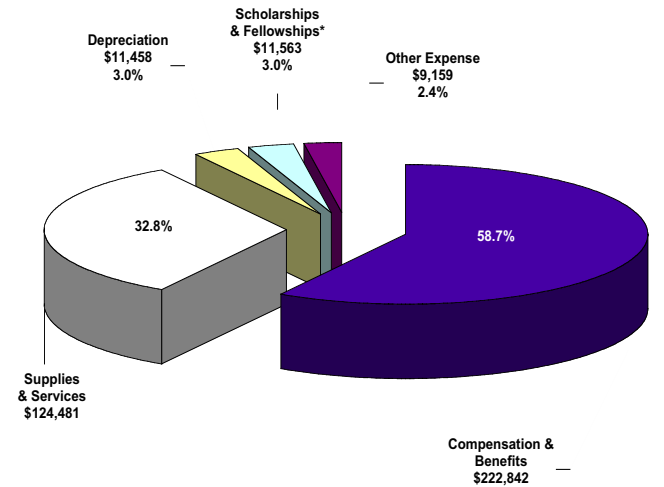


Total University Funds Fiscal Year 2003
