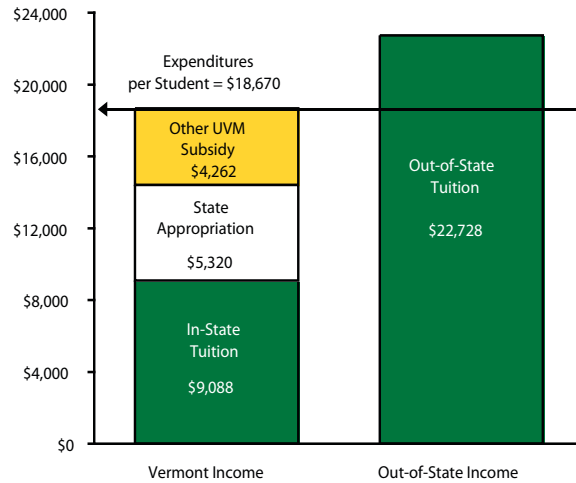

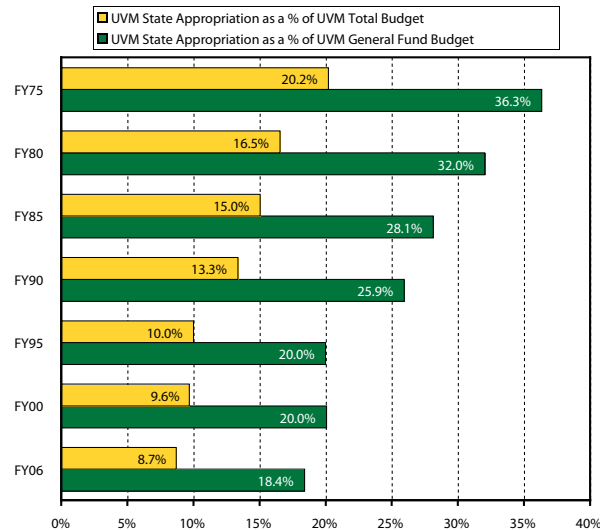
FY 2005 Expenditures per Student vs. Income Sources

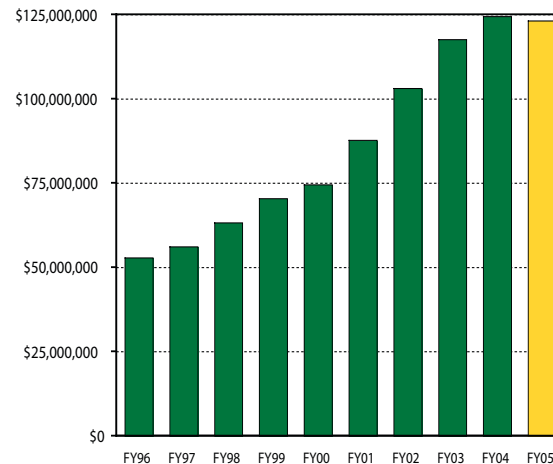

About 68% of Vermont and 54% of out-of-state undergraduates receive financial aid.

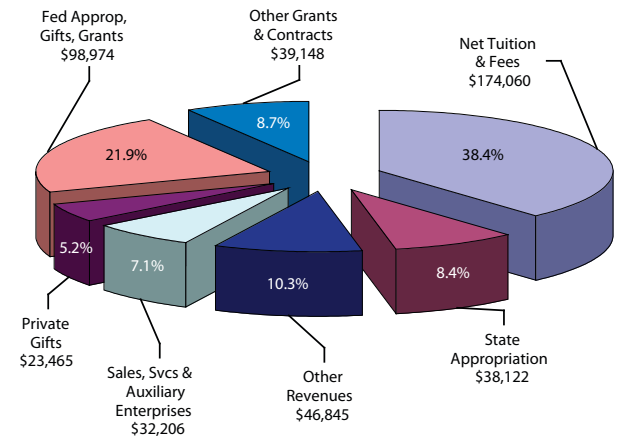
Sponsored Program Awards, FY 1996- FY 2005

In FY 2005, UVM was granted 717 sponsored program awards, resulting in a total of \$123.1 million.

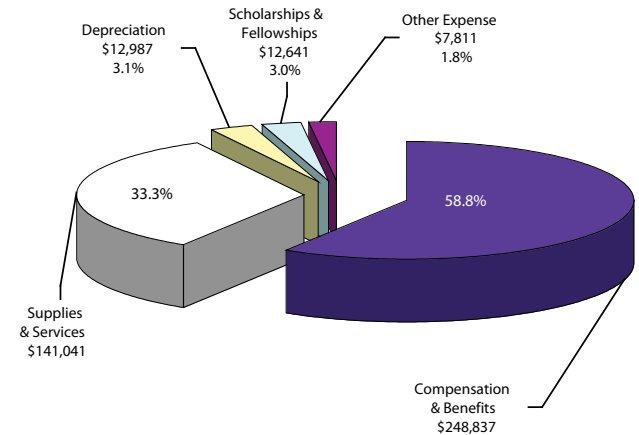


Total University Funds Fiscal Year 2005

In FY 2005, scholarships and fellowships totaled \$50.1 million. Expense of \$12.6 million represents amounts paid directly to students. Remaining amount of \$37.5 million, representing "scholarship allowances," was applied to student accounts for tuition and fees and residential life fees and was presented as reductions to tuition and fee revenues.
