- Scholarship in Development
- Research in Progress
- Dissemination of Completed Research

**Grant proposals are limited to two pages, double-spaced. Please include:**

- Problem Statement
- Evidence of supporting literature
- Hypotheses (if applicable)
- Methodology
- Significance of problem to nursing
- Anticipated date of completion
- Itemized budget (may be on separate page)

### **Submit:**

- Three (3) copies of proposal **without identifying information**
- A cover sheet that includes:
  - Title of study
  - Names and degrees of investigator(s)
  - Address, telephone number and e-mail of investigator(s)

**Expectations:** Recipients will submit a report to the chapter describing the progress with the scholarly work and the use of the grant. In addition to this report, award recipients are expected to give a presentation at a Kappa Tau meeting.

**Proposal deadline:** April 27, 2009
