

Title: Campus Kitchen Summer Nutrition Intern

Duration: May 26 – August 14, 2009

Description:

The Campus Kitchen at the University of Vermont is recruiting a summer intern to manage its cooking and distribution shifts and coordinate nutrition education classes for the Healthy City program's youth participants. Campus Kitchen is a student-run non-profit group that collects unused food from Dining Services, turns the food into a nutritious meal, and serves the meal to members of the Burlington community. The nutrition intern would work with a gardening intern to supervise CK UVM's weekly cooking shifts and facilitate various activities with the Healthy City youth.

Responsibilities will include:

1. Supervising Healthy City teens and other volunteers during food preparation and distribution shifts
2. Creating a binder of lesson plans, recipes and activity evaluations for use in future nutrition education programs
3. Teaching weekly nutrition classes to the Healthy City participants and integrating lessons into the weekly cooking shifts
4. Recruiting and training volunteers for CK UVM's programs, including cooking shifts and gleaning efforts

Qualifications:

Ideal candidates will be undergraduate students currently enrolled in an academic institution. Nutrition and dietetics majors are strongly encouraged to apply, but students with a general interest in the fields of nutrition, hunger alleviation and nonprofit work will be considered.
