## First Paper

Consider the following topics.

- 1. **The Incredulous Stare**: State and critically evaluate the **strongest** objection to Lewis's response to the incredulous stare.
- 2. Lewis's Objections to Ersatzism: State and critically evaluate the strongest of Lewis's objections to Ersatzism about possible worlds.
- 3. Plantinga's Distinction between A Priority and Necessity: State and critically evaluate the **strongest** objection to Plantinga's argument that necessity and a priority are not the same thing.

Please write an essay of 3-5 pages (about 1000 words) either on **EXACTLY ONE** of the above topics, or on a topic which you choose in consultation with me.

Your essay should be clearly organized and well-written. Please do not neglect to explain technical ideas in your own words. Write as if for an intelligent, interested audience with infinite patience for philosophy, but no prior knowledge.
