



Subject-Area Tutor Interest Form

The Learning Cooperative's Subject Area Tutoring Program hires students to provide on-campus tutoring to other students in primarily entry-level/large-enrollment/lower-division UVM courses. Tutors must obtain faculty recommendations for every course they wish to tutor, are paid \$9.00/hr (\$9.75/hr if receiving work-study funds), and receive paid training.

We are currently looking for tutors who will be available to tutor in these high-demand subject areas:

Subject

BSAD	Any, especially 40, 60, 61, 65, and 180
Statistics	Any
Physics	11 & 12 and/or 31 & 42, 51, 95
Math	17 (must have taken the course at UVM), Calculus through 121
Chemistry	2 semesters in general and/or organic
Biology	2 sem. of BIO and/or BCOR, especially BIO 3, 4, 6, and P BIO 201
Anatomy/ Physiology	19 & 20 or ASCI 141
Economics	11, 12, 170, 171, 172

There is much lower demand for tutors in other subjects (e.g., anthropology, sociology). However, we still get requests and so all tutors are encouraged to list and get faculty recommendations for any course that they feel they can tutor. For consistent tutoring hours tutors are encourage to list a class listed in the "high-demand" subject area's above.

Tutor qualifications:

- Attend a 3-hour tutor orientation session
- Obtain faculty recommendations for every course you wish to tutor
- Complete 5 hours of training each semester
