




Figure 4.8 The head from the front showing the planes of the face.




Figure 4.9 The head from the side.




Figure 4.10 The eye.

The basic outline of the face goes from the forehead out to the cheekbones, located slightly below the eyes, down and in slightly to the jawbone, a bit below the mouth, then in to the chin. The planes of the face give three-dimensionality to the drawing, though the actual lines would not be used. Figure 4.8 diagrams the face indicating the planes and proportions of the parts. The eyes are placed about the width of one eye apart from each other. Figure 4.10 shows the individual eye.






Figure 4.11 Various styles of indicated faces.
