

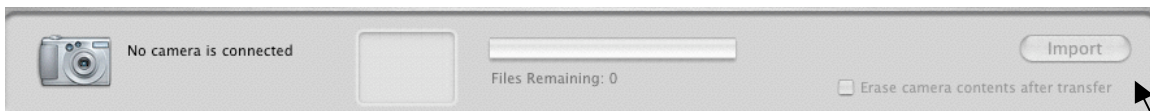
# iPhoto

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Open iPhoto from the dock by double clicking the iPhoto icon, or plugging a digital camera in to your computer.

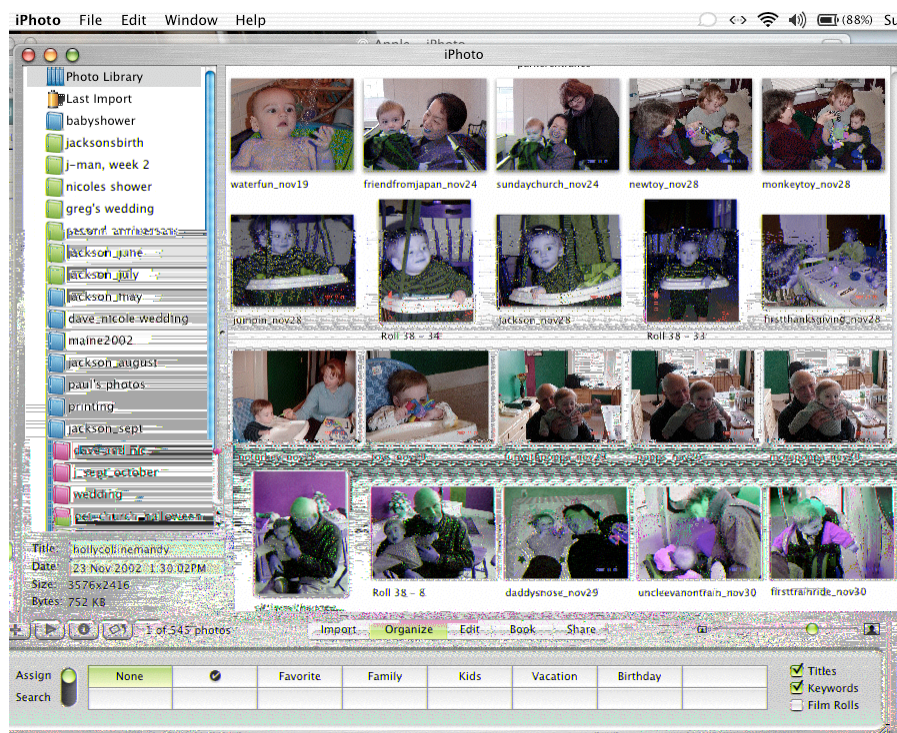


To import photos from a digital camera, plug the camera into your computer and iPhoto will automatically launch. From here you

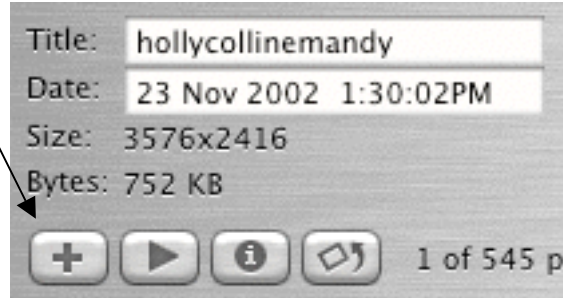


can click the import button to put all the photos from your camera into the iPhoto program.

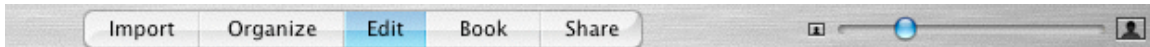
The iPhoto program opens to the organization window. This window allows you to put your photos in the order that you would like them to be in for a web page. Name photos in the **Title** area.



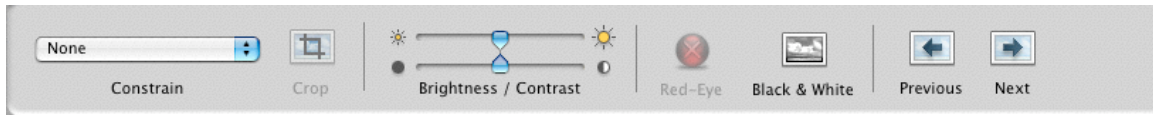
Use the plus sign button to add folders to help organize your photos. You can name the folders according to the subject of the photos.



The sideways triangle/or play button plays a slideshow of your photos with music.

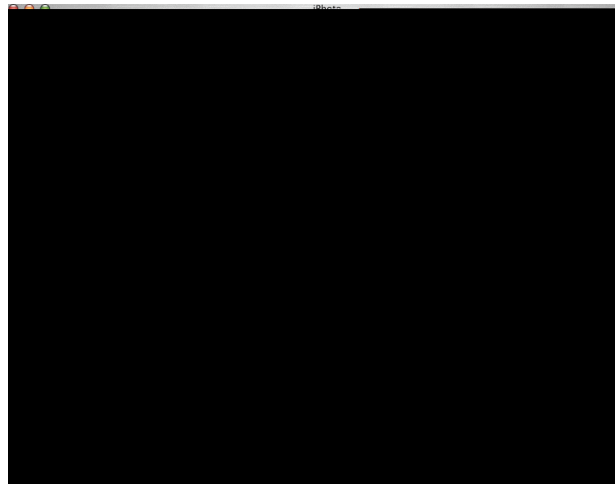
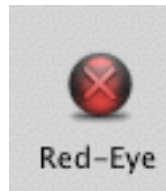


Use the enlargement bar to increase the size of the thumbnails or photos.



## Red Eye:

Select the area on the photo that has the red eye. (Be sure you have increased the size of the photo so you can select the entire portion of the eye that is red) Click the red eye button to eliminate the red eye.



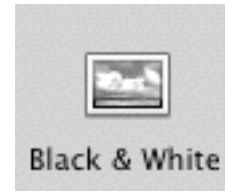
## Crop:



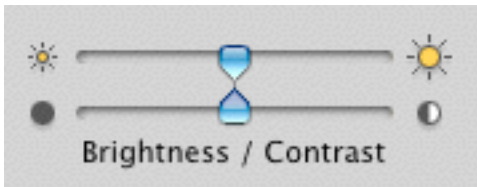
Select the portion of the photo you would like to keep by drawing a square around that area. Use the crop button to take out all the areas outside of the square you selected.

## Black and White Option:

Select the photo you want to change to Black and White, select the edit button and click on Black and White. This will change your photo immediately to black and white. You can undo this option at anytime under the edit menu.



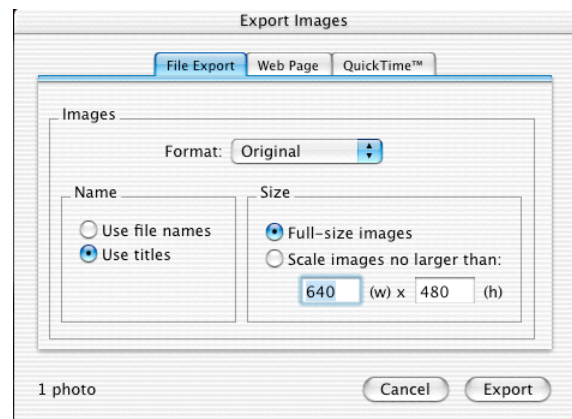
## Brightness/Contrast:



Use the sliders to increase and decrease the brightness and contrast of the photo selected.

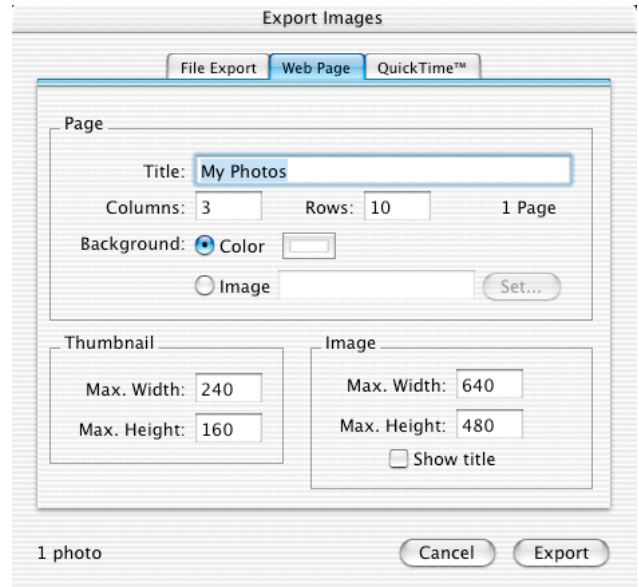
## Exporting Photo Files:

Select the photo or photos you would like to export. Go to the File menu and choose export. You may export as a file, web page or Quicktime. Under file export you can save files as jpegs.



## Exporting as a web page:

Organize your photos in to the order for your web page. You may want to use a folder to do this. Select all the images you want to export in to the web page or the folder. Then go to the File menu and select Export. Click on the Web Page tab. Fill in the options in the Web Page window.



## Exporting as Quicktime:

Select the photos you would like to save as a slideshow. Choose File and Export. Click on the Quicktime tab. Fill in the options you would like and click export. This will create a Quicktime movie slideshow.
