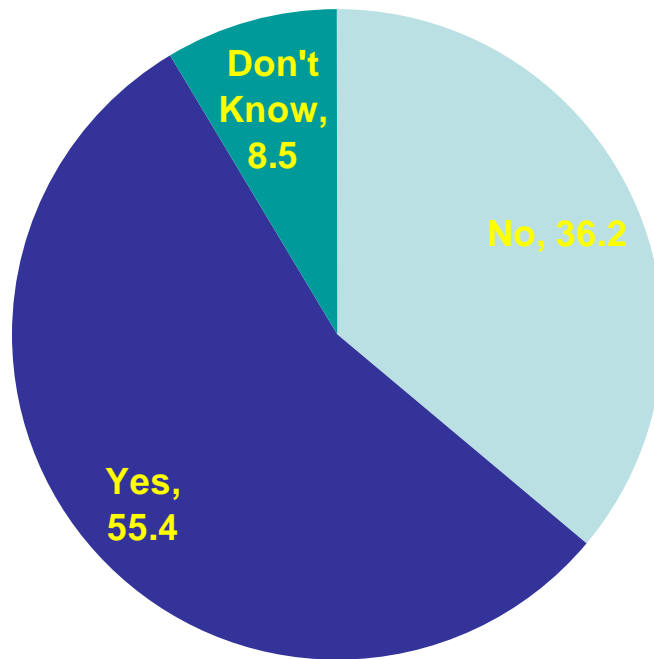
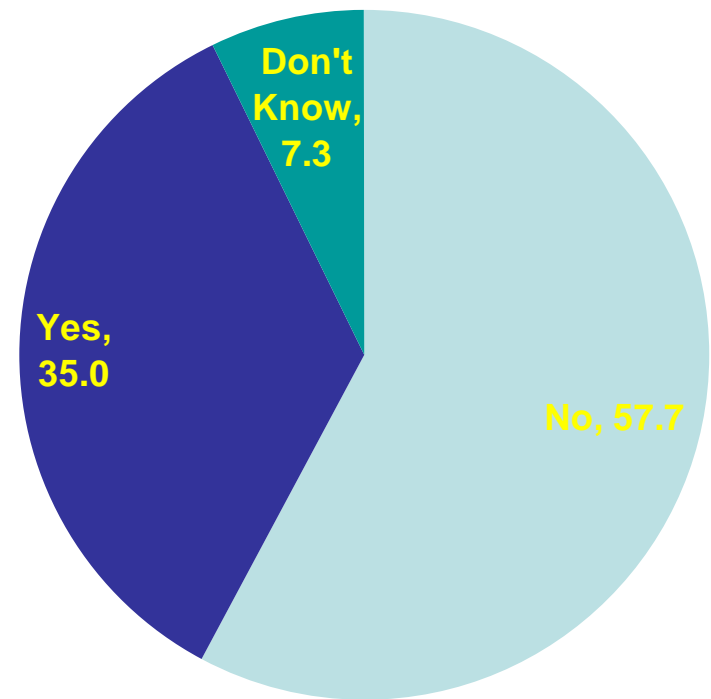

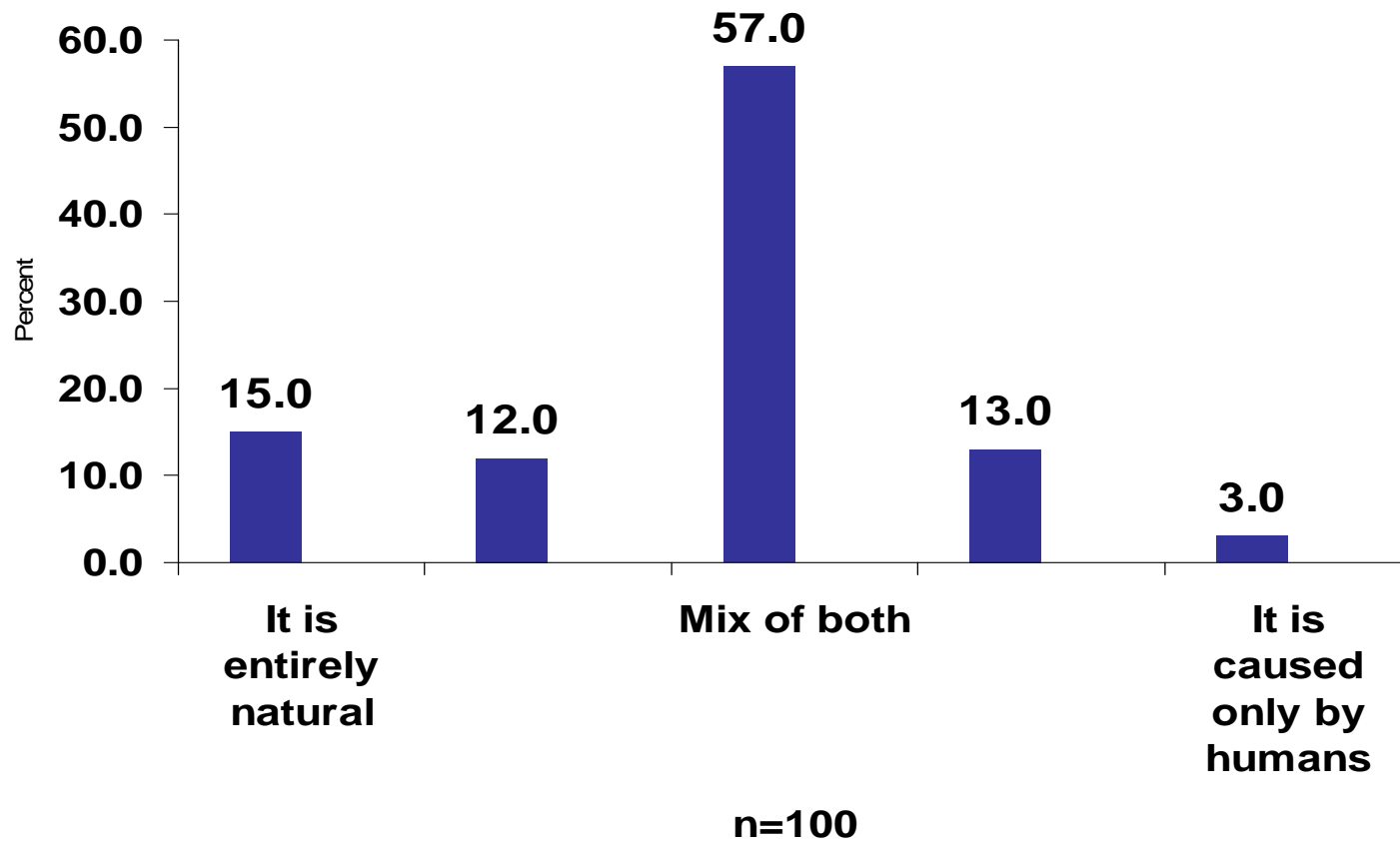


Stormwater Runoff (n=130)

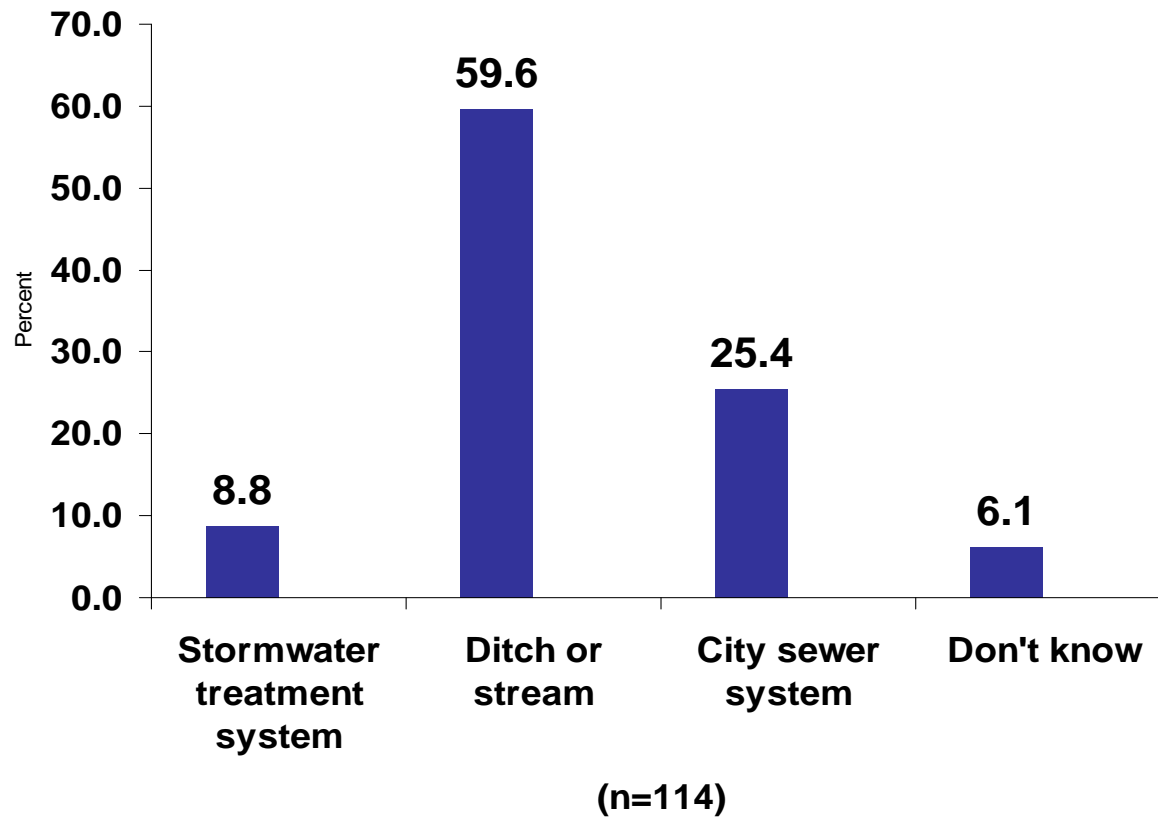

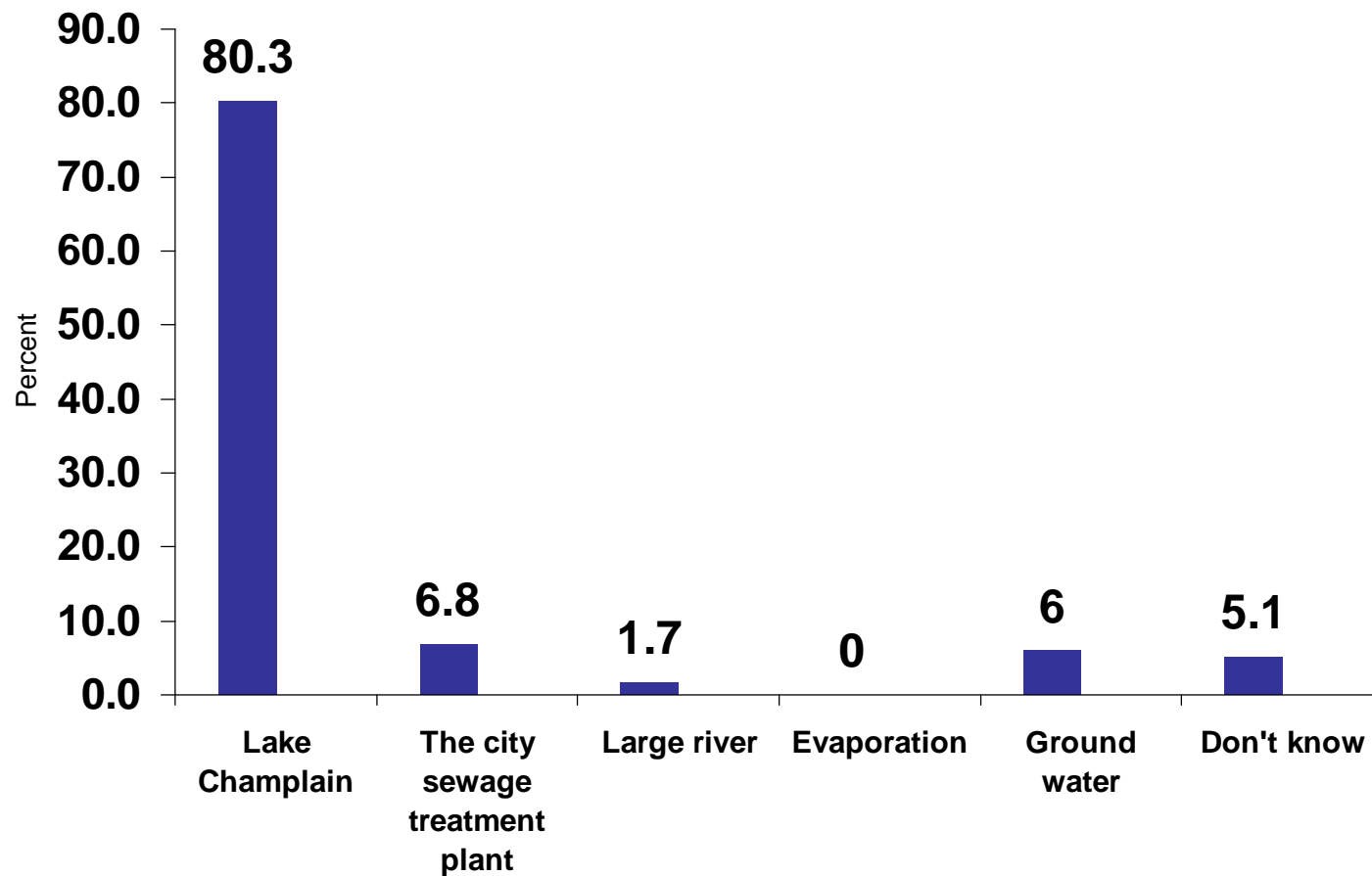
If there is flooding in your neighborhood, what do you think causes it?



When it rains in your neighborhood, where does most of the water runoff go?

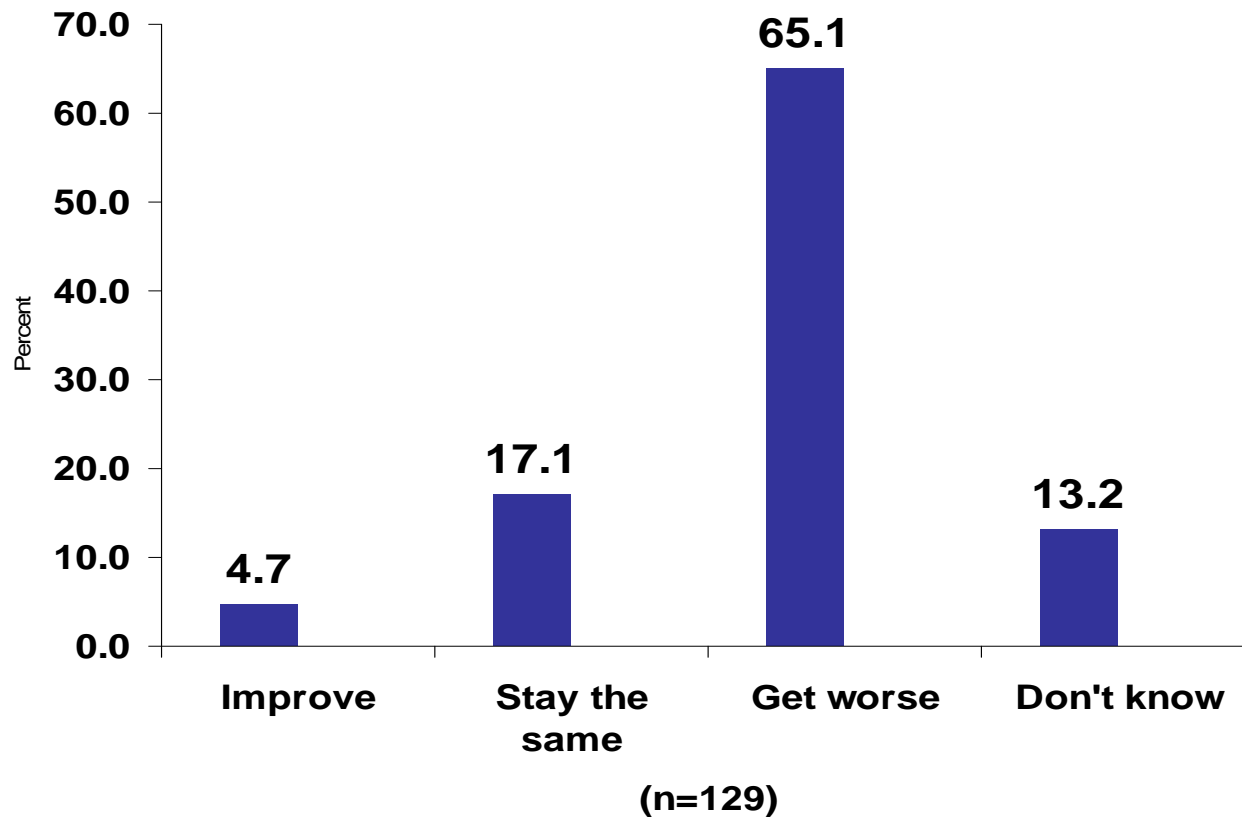

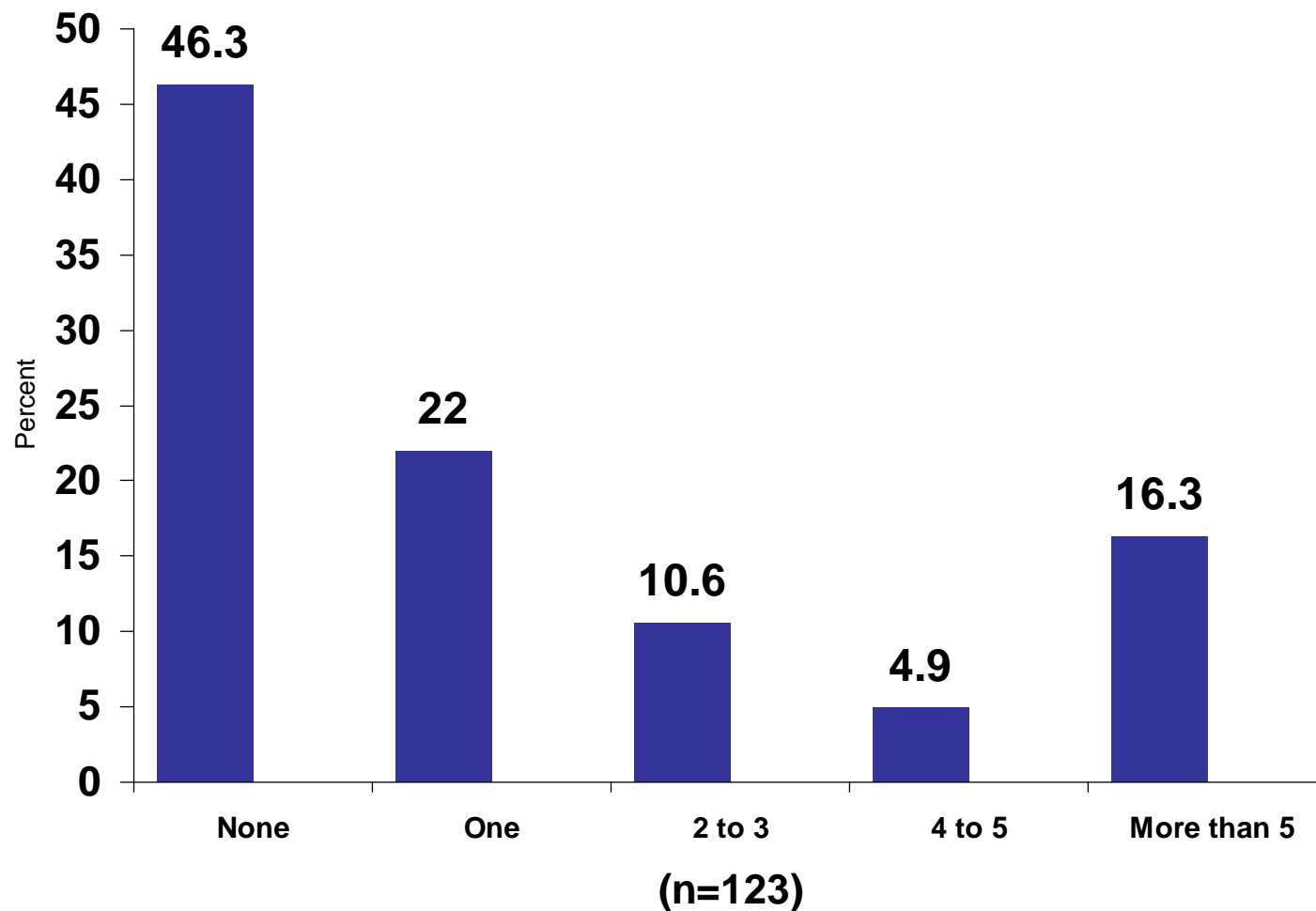

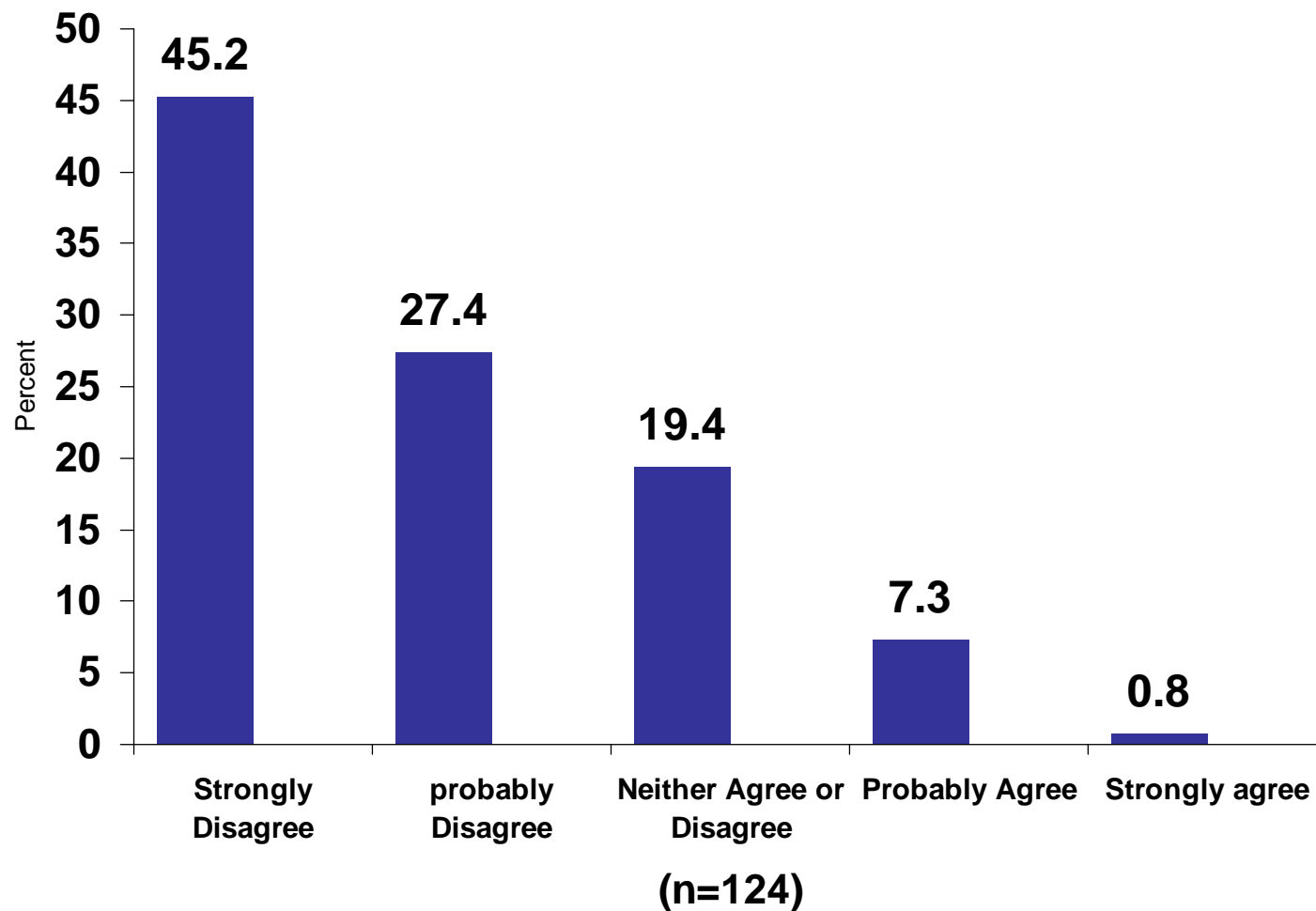

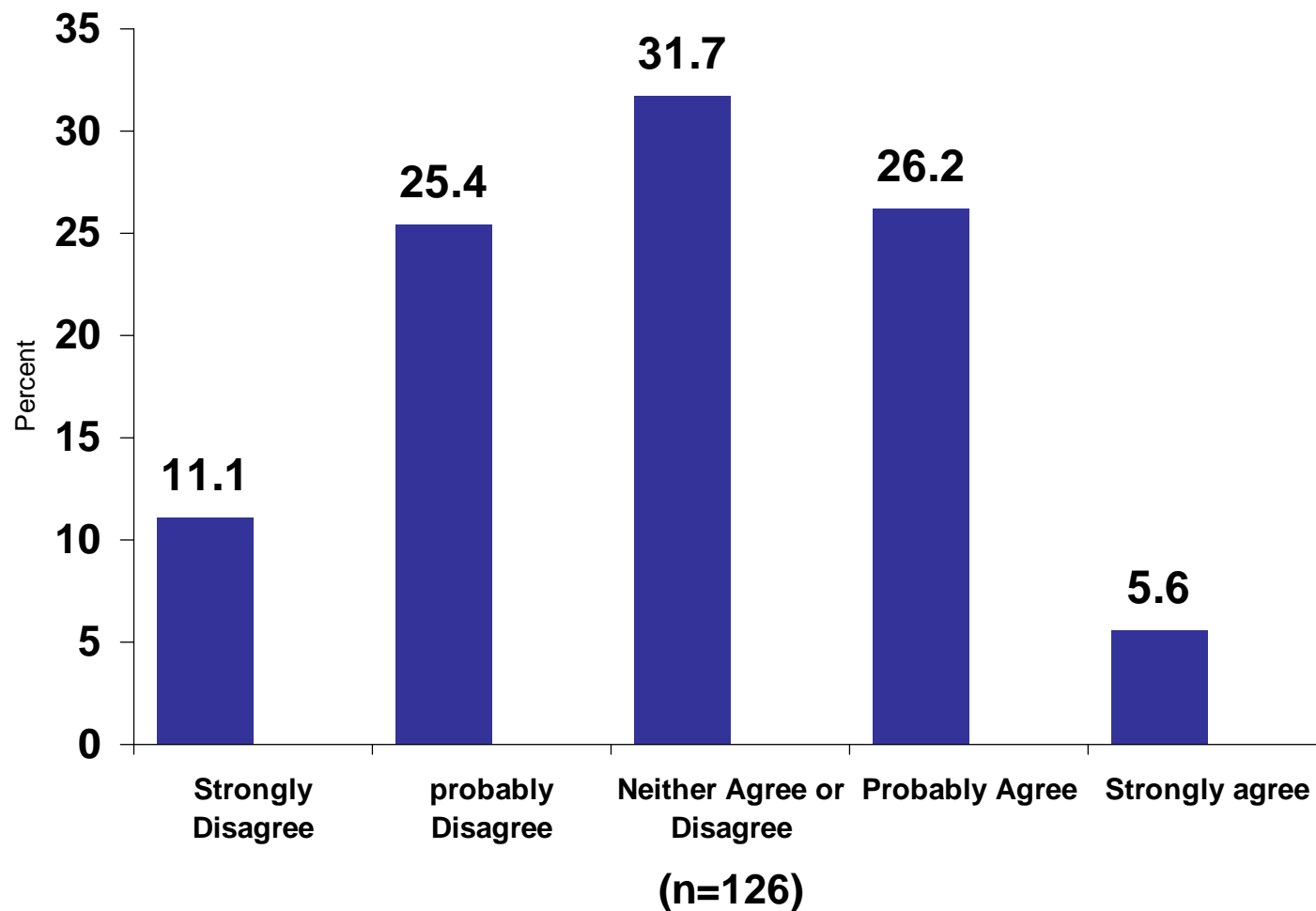

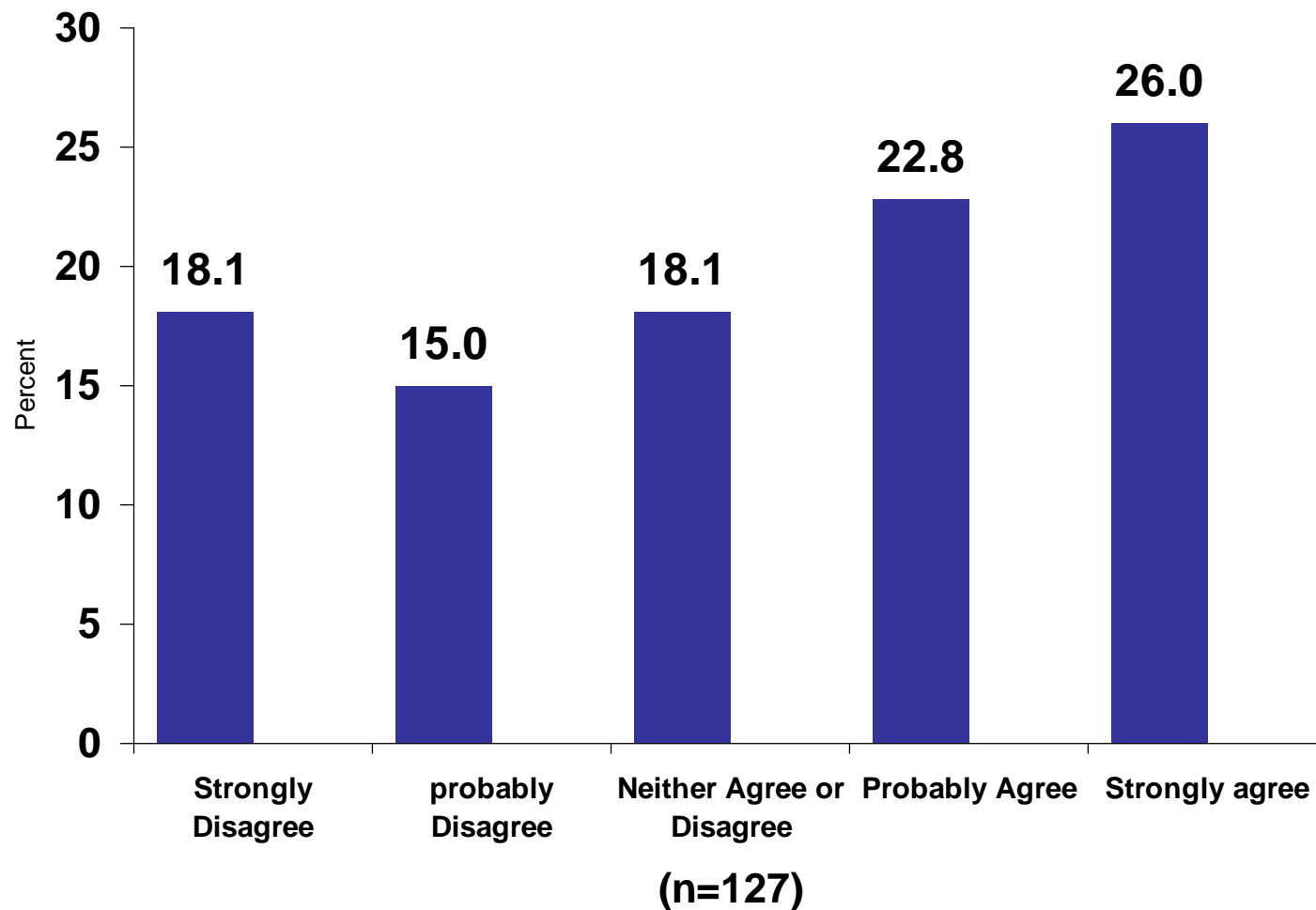

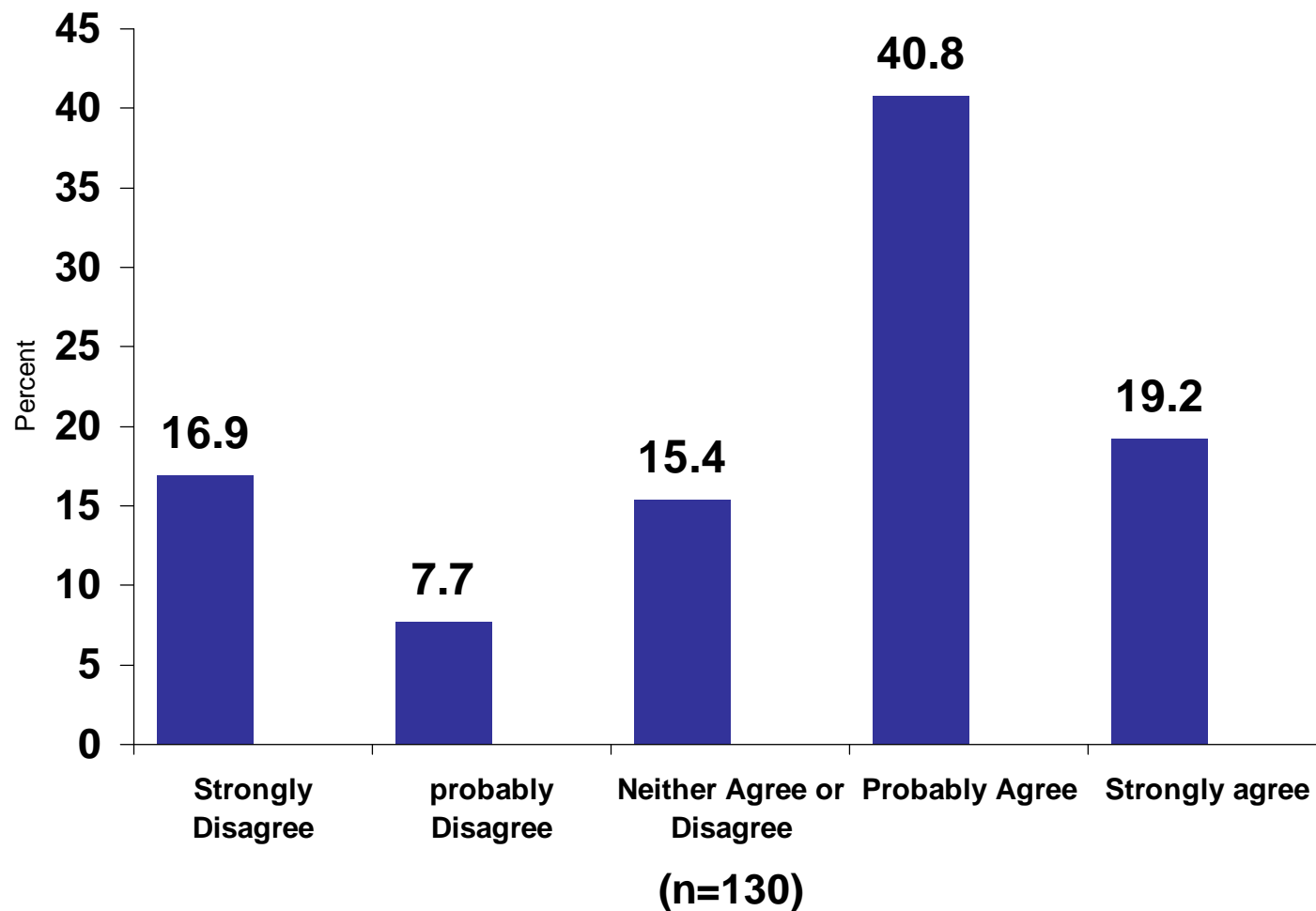

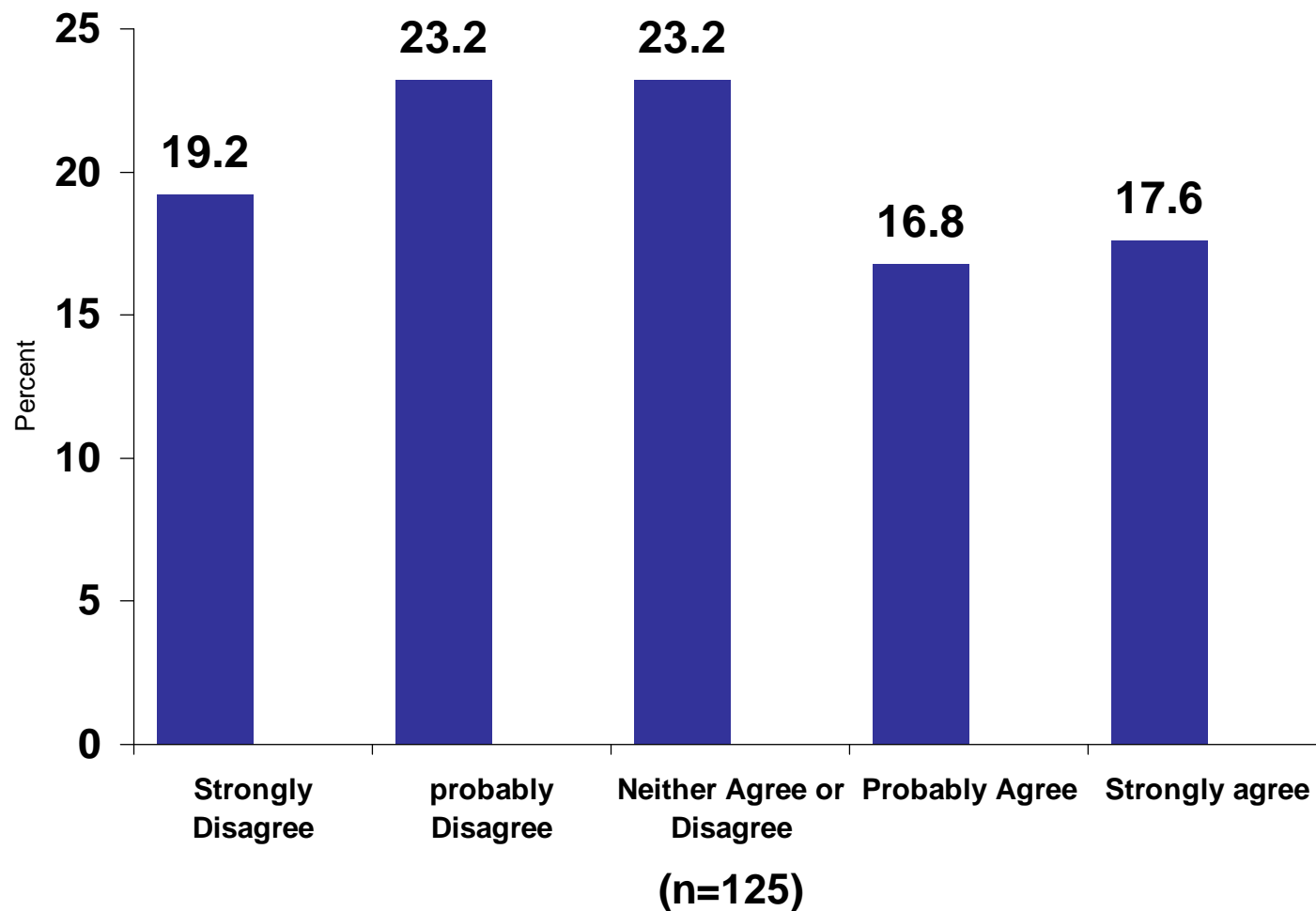

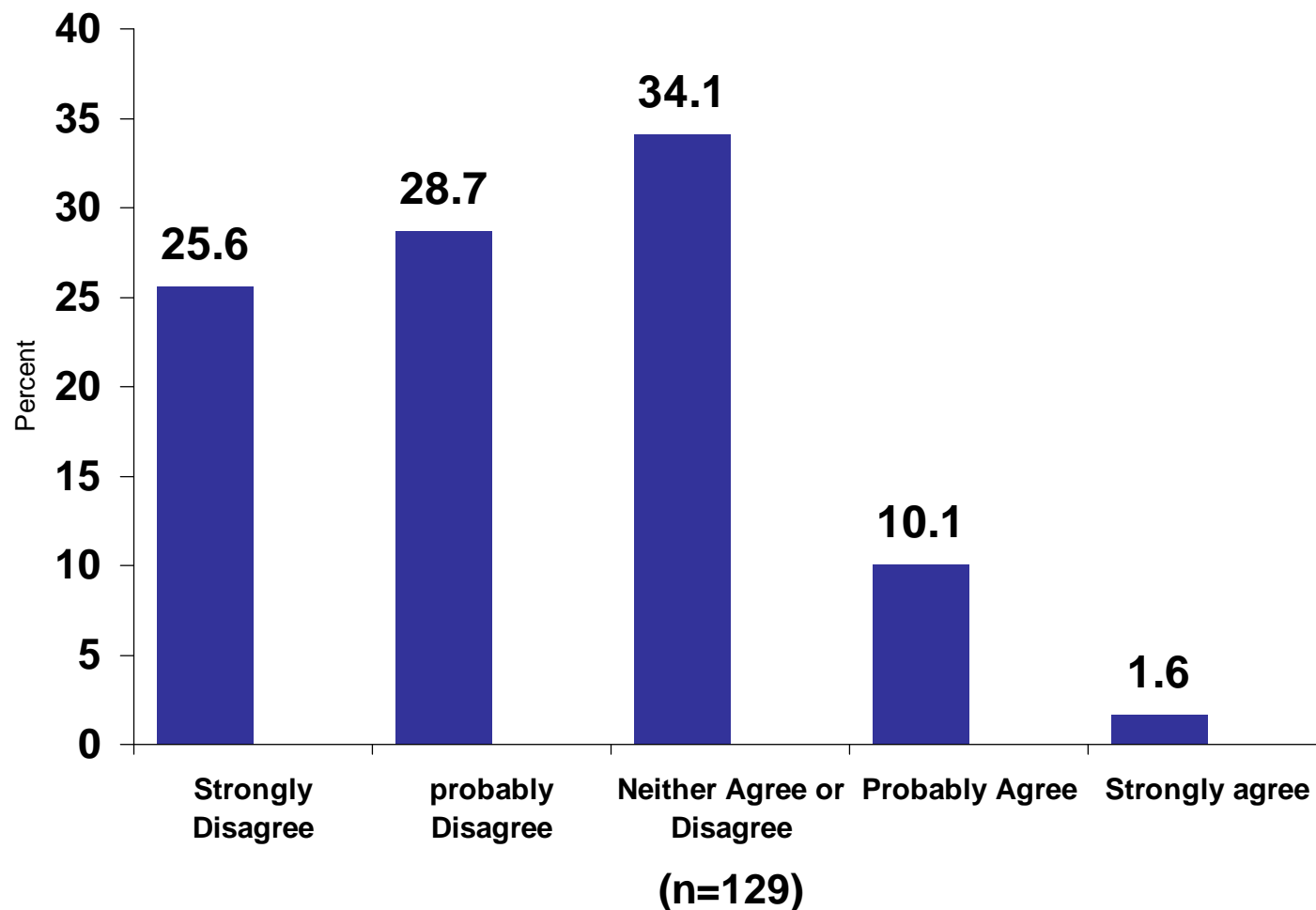

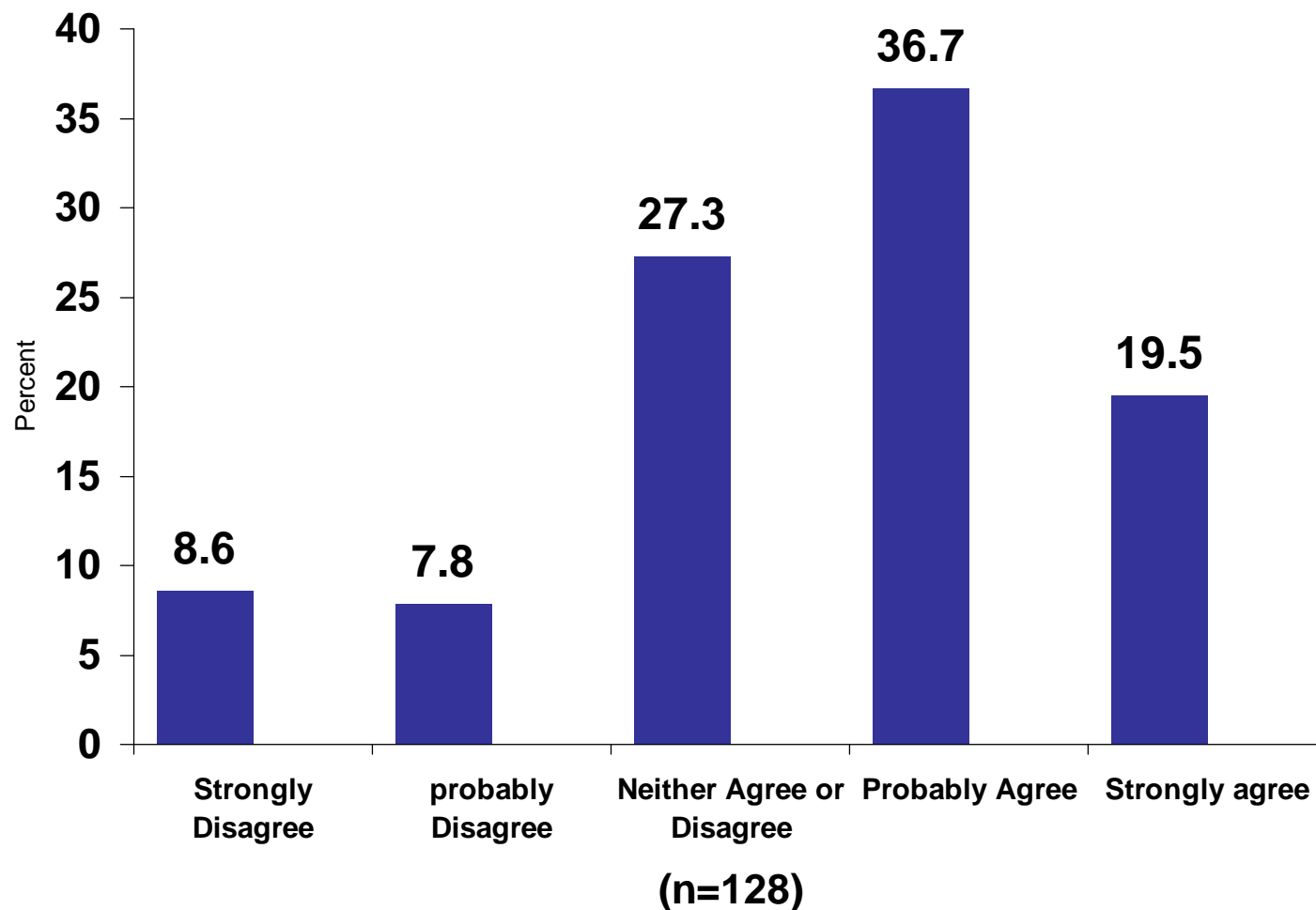

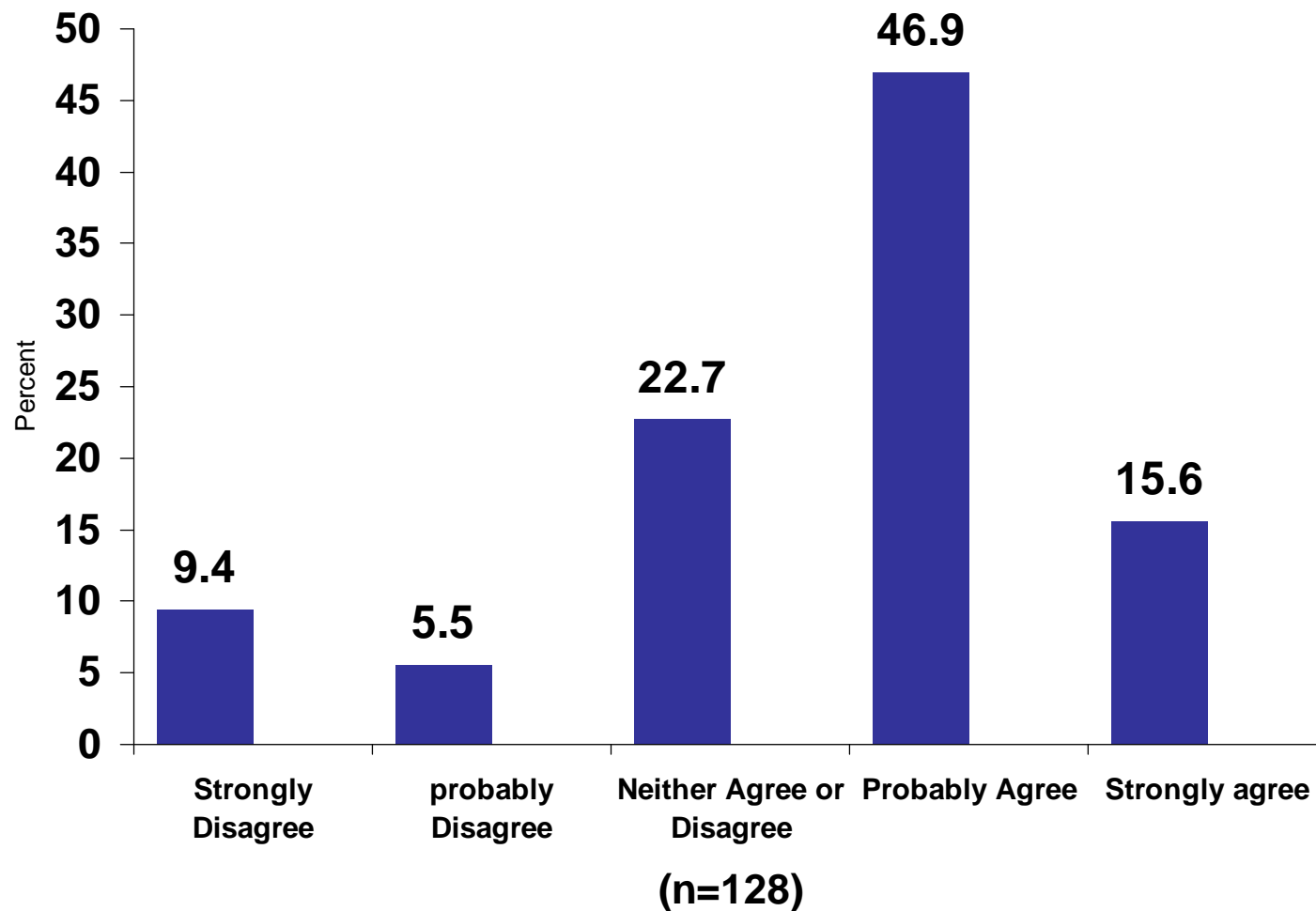

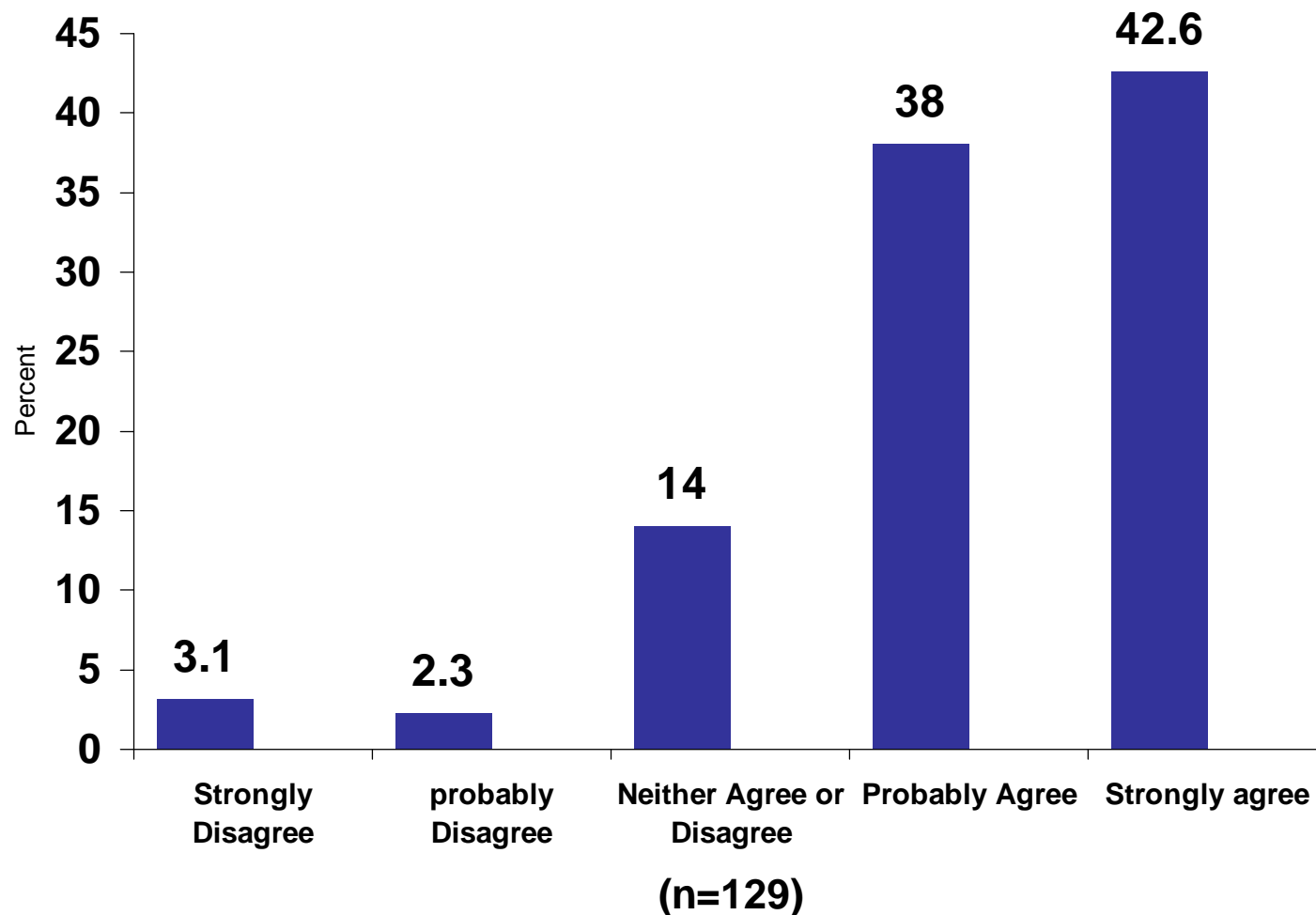

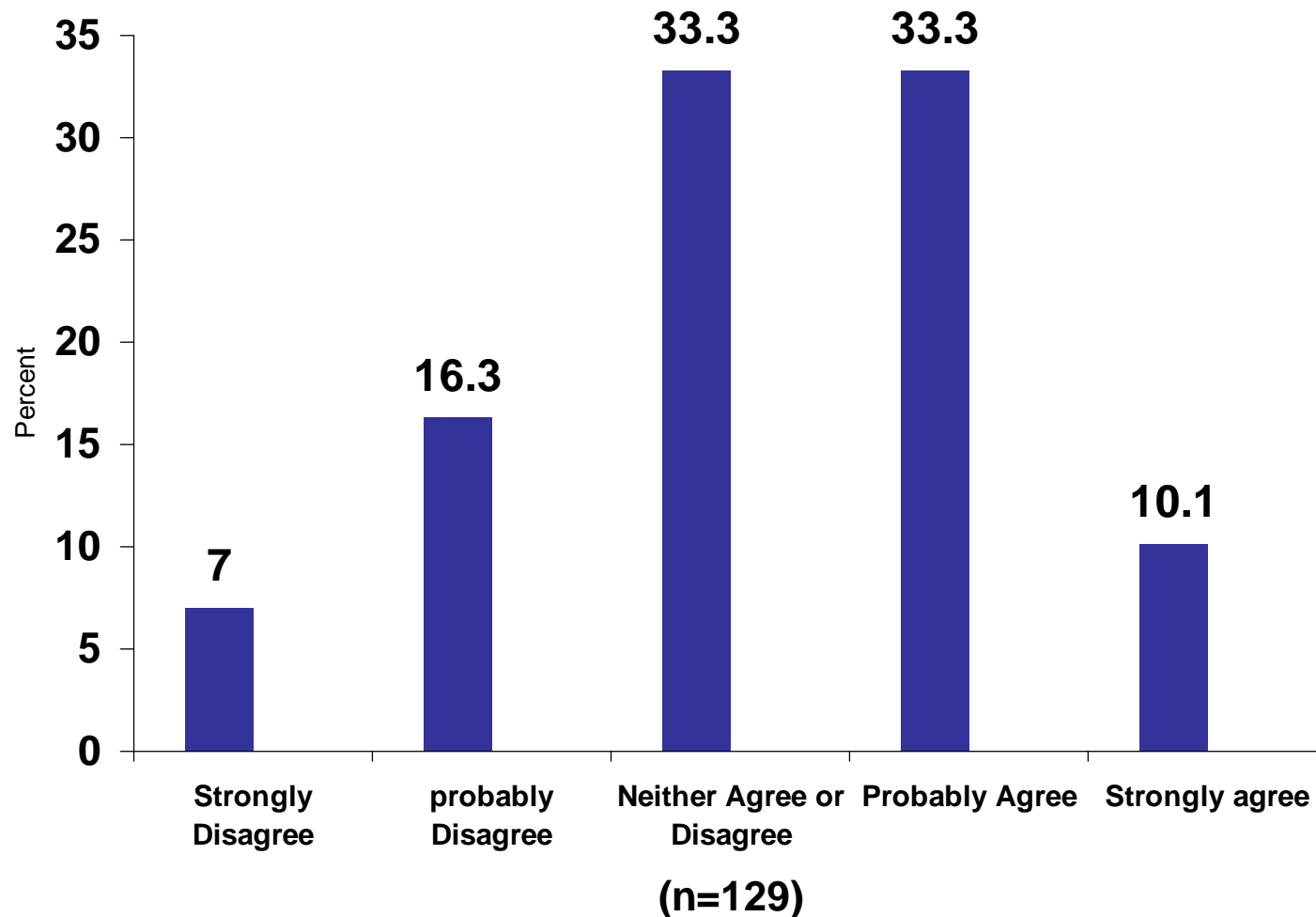

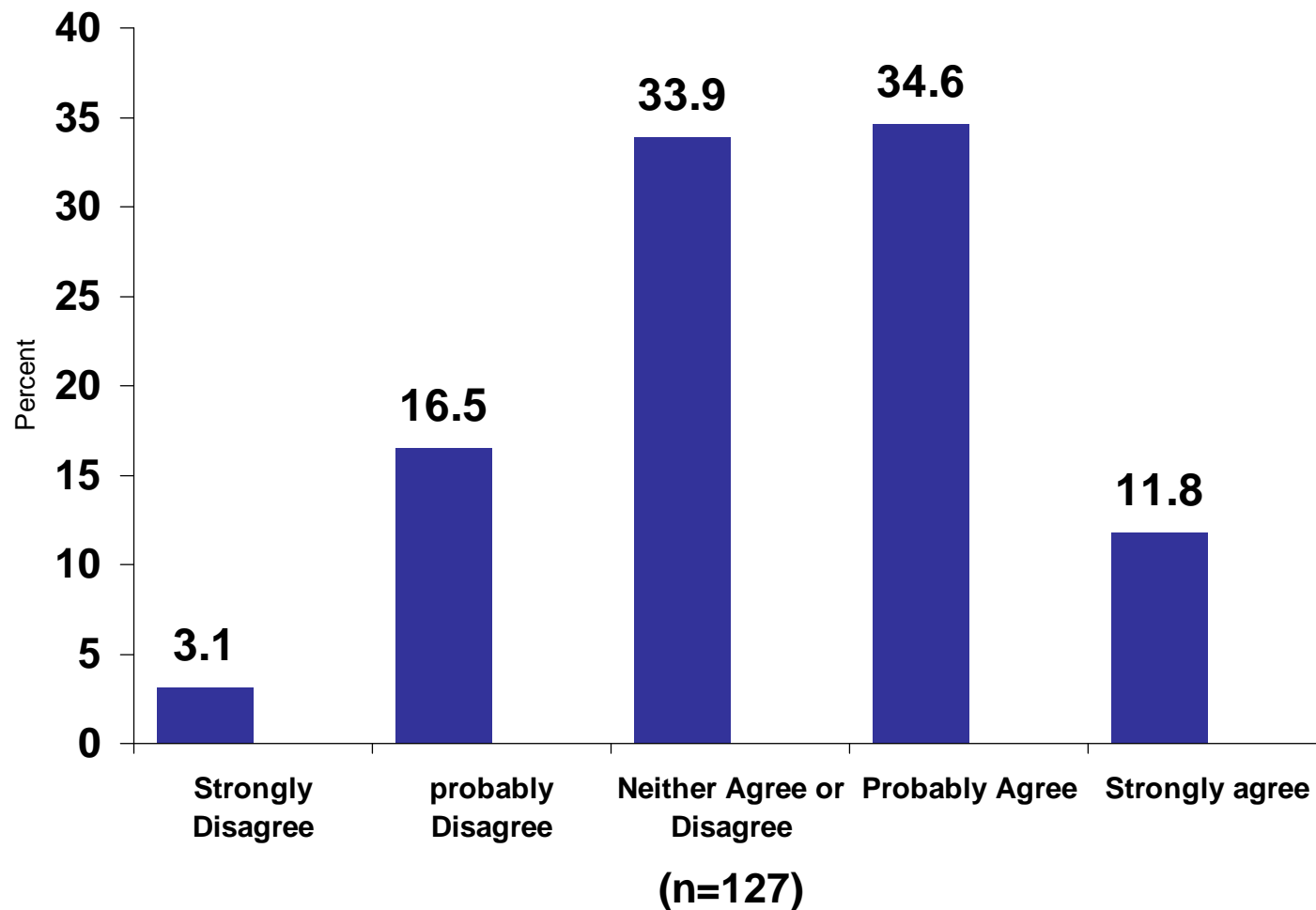

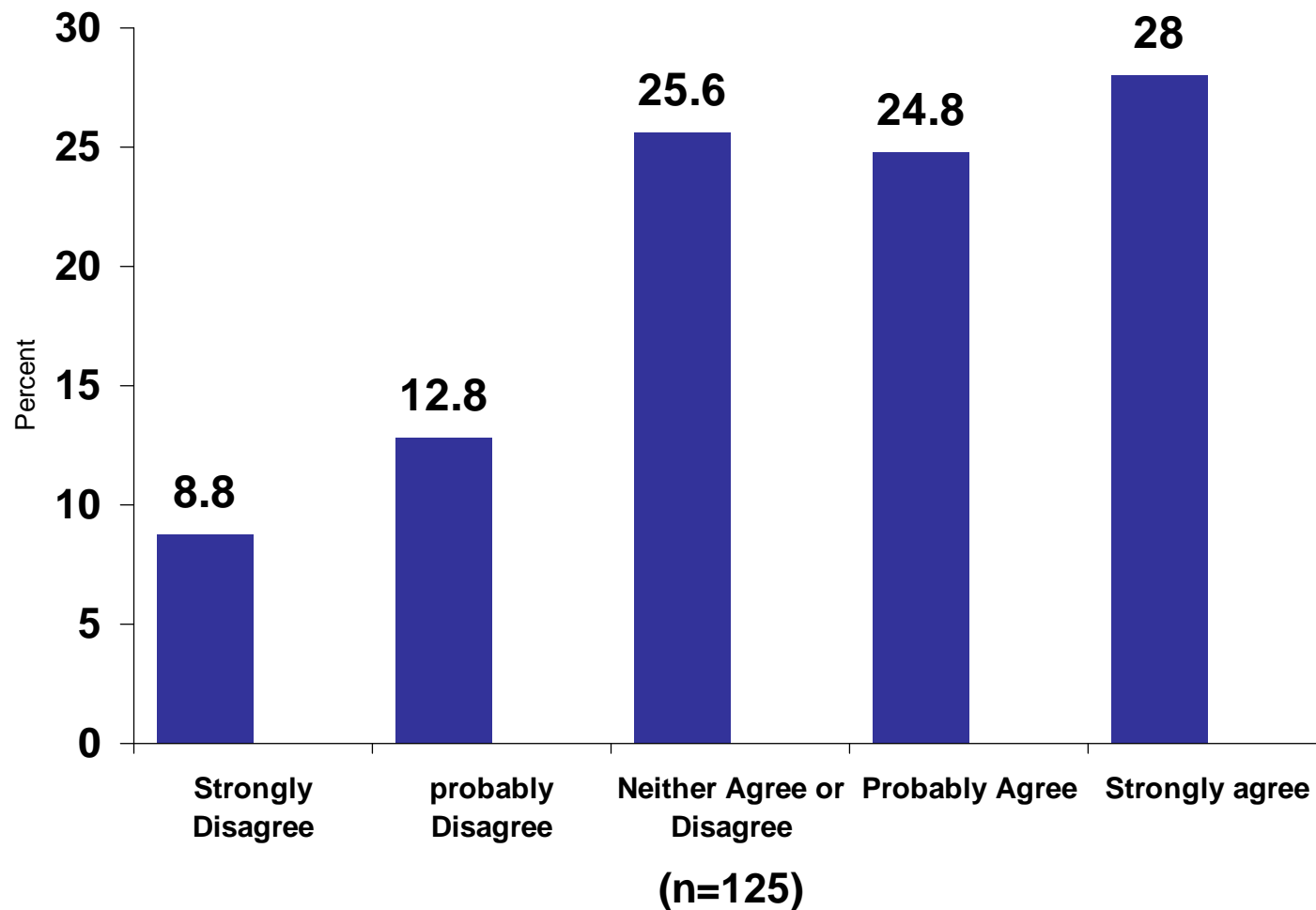

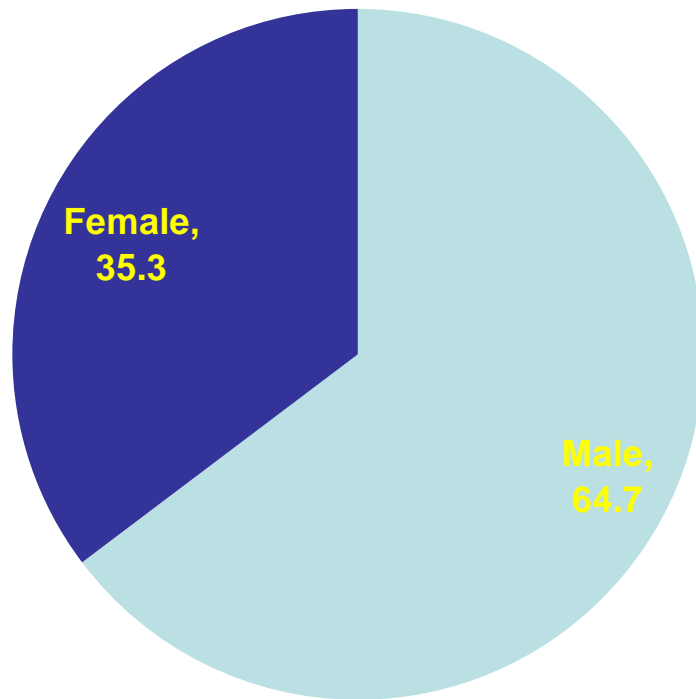

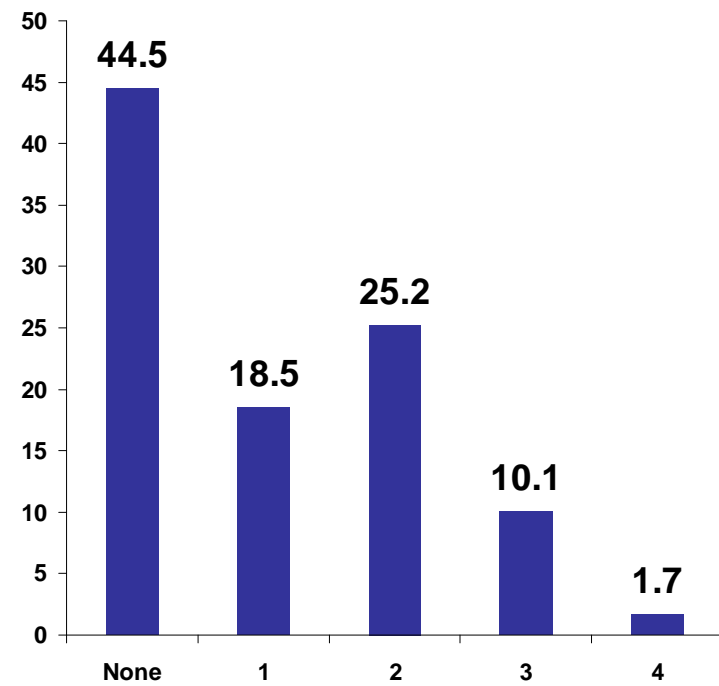

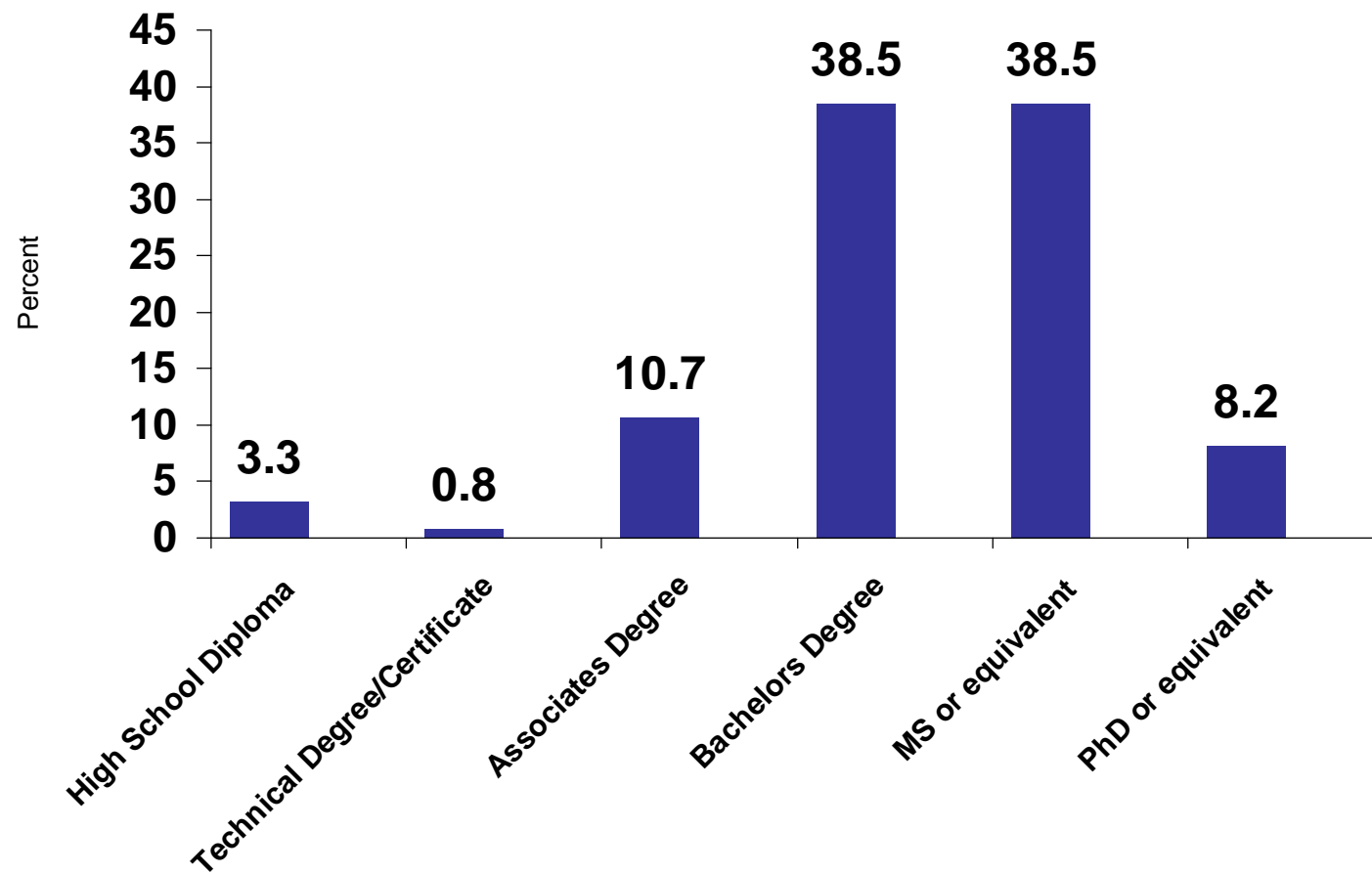

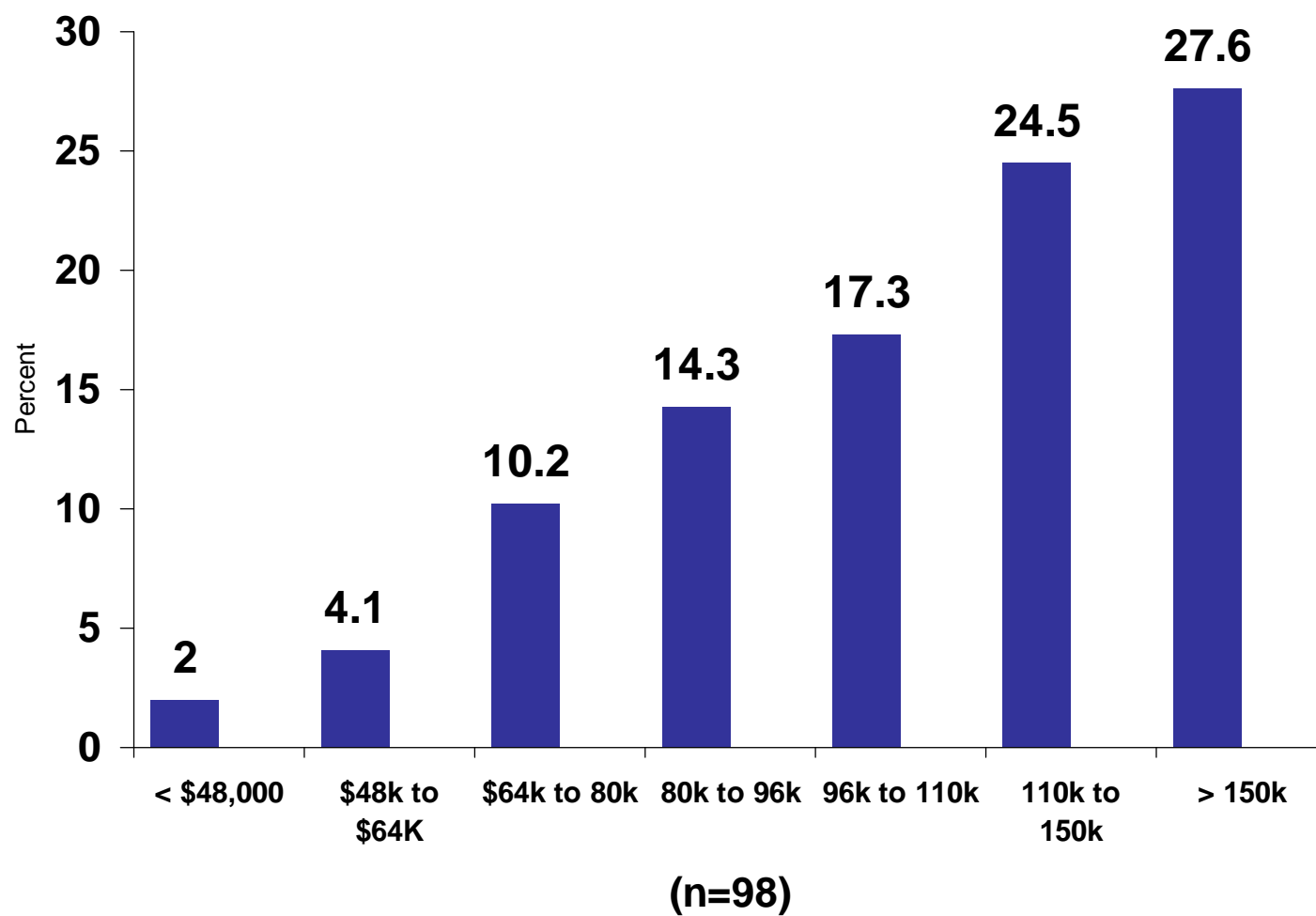
Children at Home (n=119)

Highest Degree Received

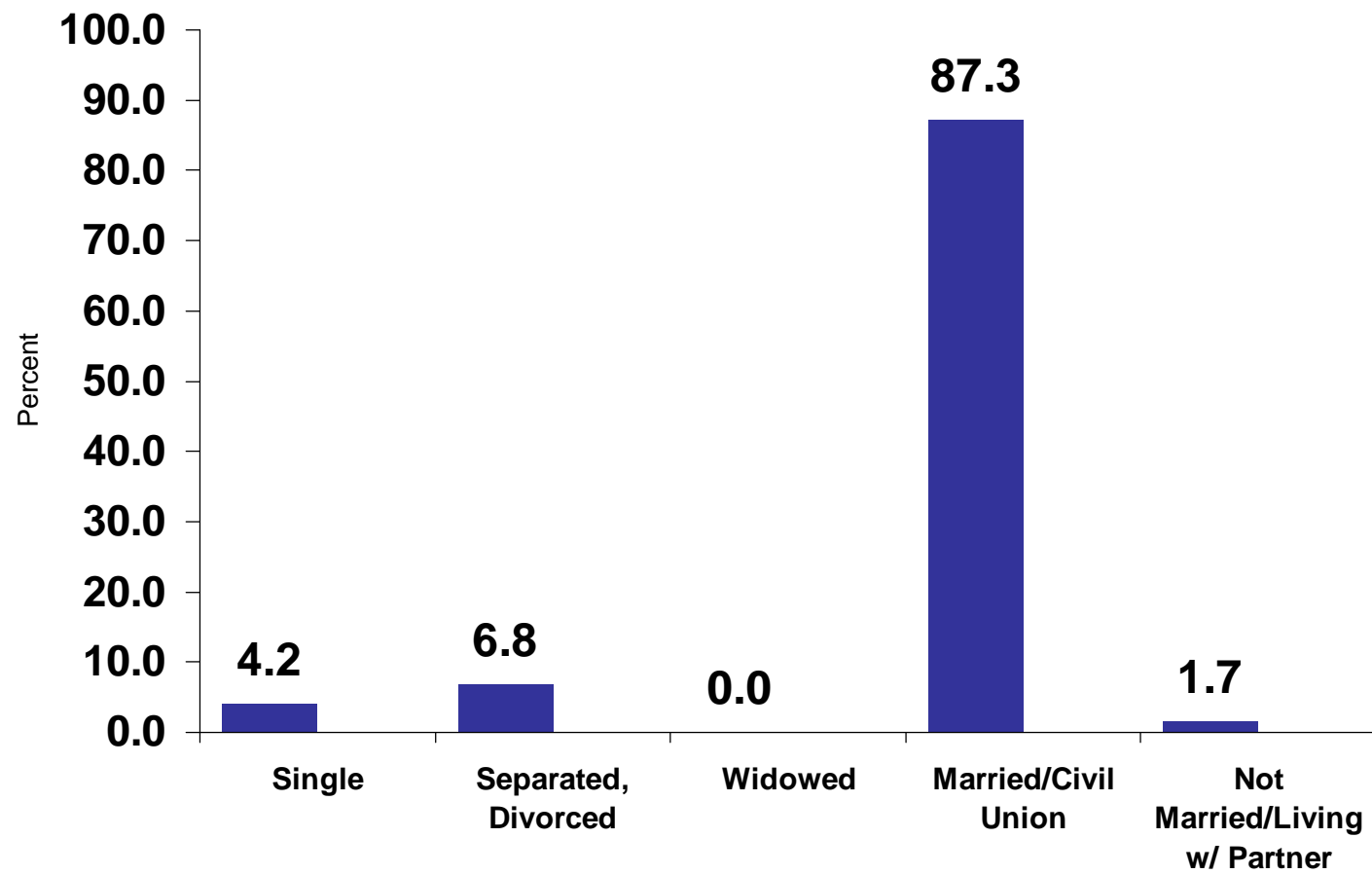

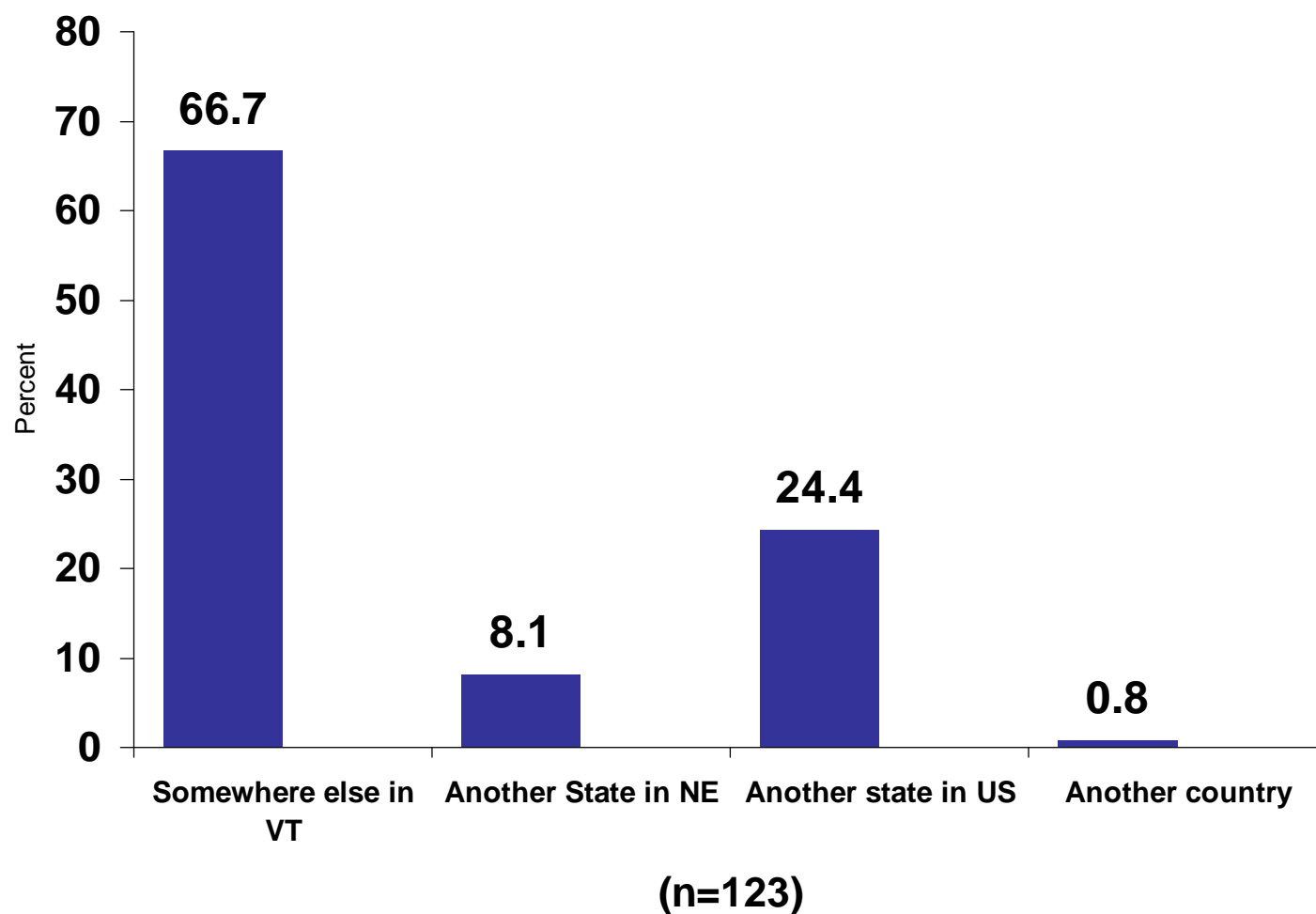


Marital Status
