Preseason Notebook

- Vermont returns eight starters and 17 letterwinners from last season's team that won the school's fourth America East Championship and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- UVM will have back the core of its defensive unit that allowed just 18 goals in all 22 games a year ago to rank 28th in the NCAA in team defense (0.77 GAA). Senior goal-keeper **Roger Scully** (0.67 GAA, 9 shutouts) returns along with senior backs **Connor Tobin**, **Jake McFadden** and **Will Haywood**. Tobin has been an all-conference selection three straight seasons picking up first team honors as a junior. Scully was named to the All-America East second team and was the America East Championship Most Outstanding Player last year.
- Three of the team's top five scorers return, seniors **Lee Stephane Kouadio** and **Jordan Crasilneck**, and junior **T.J. Gore**. Kouadio (4-2-10) has led the Cats in scoring in two of the past three seasons while Crasilneck (2-1-5) already ranks fourth in career assists (15) at UVM. Gore (3-1-7) has been on the all-conference team in each of his two seasons earning second team honors in 2007. The trio accounted for eight of Vermont's nine game-winning goals last season.
- Top midfielders returning for the Catamounts include junior **Dominic Chapman** and sophomore **Kyle Luetkehans**.
- Highlighting the 10 newcomers joining the team are a pair of soph transfers from Western powers, M/B **Ryan White** (UCLA) and M/F **Gardner Morrow** (New Mexico).

Cat-Nips ...

• Vermont won its fourth America East title and its first since 2000. The Catamounts made their eighth appearance in the NCAA Men's Soccer Championship in 2007 and advanced to the second round for the second time.

•The Catamounts had an incredible midseason turnaround in 2007 starting the campaign 4-9-0 before running off an eight-game unbeaten string that featured seven straight shutouts including two in the America East Championship.

• The Catamounts, who ranked 28th in the NCAA in team defense, recorded nine shutouts in 2007 to tie for the third-most in a single-season in program history. UVM's seven straight shutouts late in the season was the second longest scoreless streak in school history.

• Goalkeeper **Roger Scully** ranked 15th in the NCAA in save percentage (.846) and 19 in goals against average (0.67). Scully was named the Most Outstanding Player of the America East Championship after recording a pair of shutouts. In four career games in the conference tourney, he has a 0.21 GAA allowing just one goal.

•Back **Connor Tobin** earned a spot on the ESPN The Magazine National Academic All-District I First Team and was named the America East Men's Soccer Scholar-Athlete for 2007.

•In 2007-08, Vermont earned a NSCAA Team Academic Award for the second straight year. The Catamounts were among 10 of the 48 teams in the 2007 NCAA Tournament to earn a NSCAA Team Academic Award.
