Campus Area Transportation System (CATS)**

CATS provides safe and convenient shuttle service for students, staff, faculty, and visitors. CATS supports alternatives to driving, helping to reduce the number of vehicles traveling on city streets and parking in lots at the center of campus. CATS is a handicap accessible service.

**Please Note:**

Smoking and open containers of alcoholic beverages are prohibited on CATS buses and all other UVM Student Codes of Conduct apply. Each bus has a capacity of 50 passengers. If the bus is running at capacity, the driver cannot board more passengers. Should a full bus pass you by, please remember that another bus will be along in 10 minutes. Also note your CATCARD can be used with Benway's Taxi (862-1010) and Friendly Fare Taxi (310-8822).

**Weekend Route**

(Friday and Saturday evenings only) First Bus: 6:15 pm – Last Bus: 2:30 am

On Friday and Saturday evenings only, CATS runs a special revised route. This route provides service to both the students moving about on campus and those who wish to visit Downtown Burlington and the surrounding neighborhood.

**6:15pm – 10:00pm:** Buses originate from Wing-Davis-Wilks every 15 minutes. This route provides service to the following stops:

**Redstone Route (On-Campus)**

First Bus: 7:20 am - Last Bus: 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

Redstone Route buses originate from Wing-Davis-Wilks, travel through the Athletic Campus to Main Campus. Shuttles run at 20 minute intervals.

Route / Stops: Wing/Davis/Wilks, rear of Coolidge Hall, Patrick Gym front entrance Harris/Millis west side, University Heights North, Davis Center (West Entrance) Royall Tyler Theatre, Billings Student Center, Kalkin Building, rear of Bailey/Howe Library, Chittenden-Buckham-Wills, Given Building, Agricultural Engineering Lot, University Heights North, Harris/Millis west side, Coolidge Hall, Wing/Davis/Wilks.

**Trinity/Waterman Route**

First Bus: 7:30 am – Last Bus: 5:45 pm, Monday through Friday.

Bus service to Waterman and Main Campus is available at 15-minute intervals starting at Mercy Hall on the Trinity Campus. After 6:00 pm service is provided from Trinity Campus to the Athletic Campus and to Redstone Campus by the On-Campus Evening bus; after 9:00 p.m. service is provided by the On-Campus Evening and Off-Campus routes.

Route / Stops: Mercy Hall, Kalkin Building, rear of Bailey/Howe Library, Chittenden-Buckham-Wills, Given Building, Agricultural Engineering, Waterman Building, back to Mercy Hall. Demand stops at Pearl Street and South Prospect St. intersection, Colchester Avenue and University Place intersection, Colchester Avenue and East Avenue intersection,

**Redstone Express Route**

First Bus: 7:30 am – Last Bus: 2:45 pm, Monday through Friday.

This express shuttle leaves the front of Robinson Hall in the Redstone Circle every 15 minutes. This bus stops at Royall Tyler Theatre, Billings Student Center and Waterman Building. The Redstone Express only operates during the fall and spring semester periods, does not run evenings, or on days when classes are not in session.

Route / Stops: Robinson Hall, Royall Tyler Theatre, Billings, Waterman, back to Robinson Hall. Demand Stops on South Prospect Street at Maple Street and Cliff Street.

**On-Campus Evening**

First Bus: 6:00 pm – Last Bus: 11:45 pm, Sunday through Thursday

Bus Service originates from Wing-Davis-Wilks, travels through the Athletic Campus, Main Campus and Trinity Campus. This bus leaves Wing-Davis-Wilks: 15, :45 to travel to Mercy Hall, Trinity Campus; leaves Mercy Hall, Trinity Campus to return to Wing-Davis-Wilks: 00, :30.

Route / Stops: Wing/Davis/Wilks, rear of Coolidge Hall, Patrick Gym front entrance Harris/Millis west side, University Heights North, Davis Center West, Royall Tyler Theatre, Billings Student Center, Mercy Hall (Trinity Campus), Kalkin Building, rear of Bailey/Howe Library, Chittenden-Buckham-Wills, Given Building, Agricultural Engineering Lot, University Heights North, Harris/Millis west side, Coolidge Hall, Wing/Davis/Wilks.

**Off-Campus Route**

First Bus: 6:30 pm – Last Bus: 12 midnight, Sunday through Thursday

Bus Service originates from Wing/Davis/Wilks at 30 minute intervals. The Off-Campus Route only operates during the fall and spring semester periods. This is a closed route - a valid UVM ID is required to board.

Route / Stops: Wing/Davis/Wilks, rear of Coolidge Hall, Patrick Gym front entrance Harris/Millis west side, University Heights North, Royall Tyler Theatre, Billings Student Center, Mercy Hall (Trinity Campus), Jeanne Mance Hall, Pearl Street at North Willard Street, Loomis Street, North Willard Street at North Street, North Street at South Union Street, North Street at South Winooski Avenue, South Winooski Avenue at Grant Street, South Winooski Avenue at Cherry Street, South Winooski Avenue at Main Street, South Winooski Avenue at Maple Street, Maple Street at South Union Street, South Prospect Street at Cliff Street, back to Wing/Davis/Wilks. Demand Stops at Colchester Avenue and Mansfield Avenue, Pearl Street at South Winooski Avenue, and Maple Street at South Prospect Street.

**Trinity Weekend Route**

First Bus: 11:30 am – Last Bus: 4:45 pm, Saturday and Sunday.

Bus Service originates from Mercy Hall, Trinity Campus and travels through Main Campus to Redstone Campus. This bus (or van depending on ridership) leaves Mercy Hall, Trinity Campus :00, :30 to travel to Wing-Davis-Wilks; leaves Wing-Davis-Wilks :15, :45 to return to Mercy Hall, Trinity Campus.

Route / Stops: Wing/Davis/Wilks, rear of Coolidge Hall, Patrick Gym front entrance Harris/Millis west side, University Heights, Davis Center West, Royall Tyler Theatre, Billings Student Center, Mercy Hall (Trinity Campus), Kalkin Building, rear of Bailey/Howe Library, Chittenden-Buckham-Wills, Given Building, Agricultural Engineering Lot, University Heights North, Harris/Millis west side, Coolidge Hall, Wing/Davis/Wilks.

**Midnight Special**

First bus: 12:30 a.m. until 2 a.m. finals week.

CATS runs a special shuttle for students studying late at the Bailey/Howe Library during finals week. The Midnight Special will transport students to their residences on campus and within a two-mile radius of campus. Students may board this bus at the Royall Tyler Theatre stop. Look for the special “Midnight Special” barricade. Last bus leaves the stop at 2 a.m.
