Veteran's Day Act

WHEREAS, Veterans Day became an official Federal Holiday replacing Armistice Day on October 8th, 1954 when President Eisenhower made the first "Veteran's Day Proclamation"

WHEREAS, Veterans Day since 1954, has been an American Tradition to celebrate all those who have fought for the United States during times of strife and war

WHEREAS, the University of Vermont does not recognize Veteran's Day as an official holiday for the students and community that it serves and represents.

WHEREAS, THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VERMONT WILL HOST THE 1ST STUDENT RUN VETERANS DAY CELEBRATION ON NOVEMBER 11TH, 2009.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Student Government Association of the University of Vermont supports the declaration of Veteran's Day as a student recognized holiday by the SGA.

Be it further Resolved, that the Student Government Association also urges the Presidential Administration in conjunction with the Student Government's Committee on Legislative Action (C.O.L.A.) to take steps to ensure that a celebration occurs on Veteran's Day annually to honor those who have served our country.
