Food Systems is a nascent field of study nationally and an emerging strength at UVM that is particularly well-suited to the UVM Land Grant mission of research and engagement in the 21st century.

The focused investment in a UVM Food Systems Spire is intended to give our University the ability to inform complex 21st-century issues — in Vermont and around the world — surrounding food production, the environment, nutrition and public health, food security, food safety, rural economic development, biofuels, and more.
