





Containers: Totes, Lugs, Cartons, Bins, Boxes


- What crops?

- Is the container ergonomic?




Mechanics Tools

“The hose trollies are so wonderful. The hoses are never on the ground, and they are never tangled. Placing them strategically so that each zone of the wash station has its own hoses is a dream. It used to be all "hey, which hose are you using? Can you use this other one so I can reach this one?" And then we'd spend 5 minutes untangling. SUCH NONSENSE!!”



Hose Reels & Trolleys


- Helpful to have multiple hose drops/spigots
- Aim to keep hoses off the ground
- Routing/location

Hoses & Nozzles

- Consider quality for point of use
- Hose diameter/Flow Rate
- Use of Quick Connects



Cleaning tools

- “*What are you cleaning?*”
- Tools should be cleanable
- Consider color coding
- Easily accessible
- When to replace?



Squeegees

- Water happens
- Drying is important
- Aides in drying
- Slip/trips/falls




Hook Sticks

“This one's a Diggers original, invented by my farm partner Elango Dev: hook sticks. A long tool handle (like a hoe handle) with a hook screwed into the end of it. Now with our rolling dollies we don't use them as much in the wash station, but they ride around in every truck, for pulling stacks of clamshell totes out. This way you can stand at the end of the truck and pull the load without crawling all up into the truck.” – Hilary Martin
