



A healthy sheep is a happy sheep! Knowing what is “normal” for your sheep can be a matter of life or death.


Do you know:

**The average rectal temperature of a sheep is 102.5. The range is 102.5 to 103 (F).**

What is the Respiratory Rate of a sheep (breaths/min)? **The average is 20 with a range of 10-20.**

What is the Heart Rate (beats/min)? **The average is 75 with a range of 70-90.**
