4-H Shooting Sports is an active project, attractive to both youth and adults. 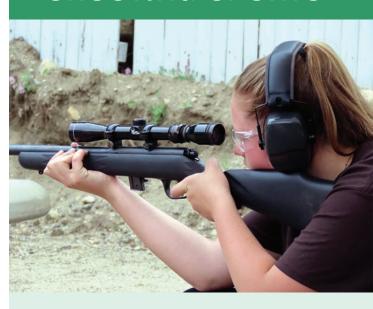
