How do I enroll? Simply complete the enclosed enrollment form, sign, and mail it.

When do I have to enroll by? Each individual enrolling in the plan must return a signed enrollment form using the enclosed envelope by December 1, 2024.

When will my coverage start? Your new Medicare Advantage plan will be effective January 1, 2025.

Vermont Blue Advantage Group PPO is a Medicare Advantage plan

Medicare Advantage plans are approved by Medicare and administered by private insurance companies. Medicare Advantage plans provide all your Original Medicare Part A (hospital) and Part B (medical) benefits.

Your Vermont Blue Advantage plan also provides additional benefits not covered under Original

Medicare, such as travel benefits and telehealth via Teladoc Health.

Important information

- You can only be enrolled in one Medicare Advantage plan at a time.
- Enrolling in this plan **automatically disenrolls** you from any other Medicare Advantage health plan or Part D Medicare Prescription drug plan in which you are enrolled.
- Medicare has an annual enrollment period for individuals who aren't eligible for a group plan; therefore, you may receive information in the mail about other healthcare options. If you choose to enroll in a different individual Medicare plan (one that is not offered through your employer group), any coverage you have through this plan will be cancelled. You will not be able to enroll in this group PPO plan until the next enrollment period. Please check with your employer group for future enrollment eligibility.
- If you or another Medicare-eligible member on your employer group coverage has other insurance coverage that pays on a claim before your employer group coverage and you wish to keep that insurance arrangement, please call your employer group.
