## **Application Deadline: Postmarked by August 1**

The Big E kindly has a scholarship opportunity available to honor 4-H youth who have participated at Eastern States each year. Vermont is eligible to award one youth every other year, and it's our time again (awarded on odd numbered years). The scholarship award is for \$500 towards a 2 or 4 year college program or a technical/vocational degree of some sort.

**Eligibility Criteria:** The 4-H member/applicant must currently be a senior in high school, or a freshman in college (this current year that students are just beginning) **AND** they must have attended ESE at least once in their 4-H career (this coming ESE is ok too). Selection will be based on most experience at ESE as well as leadership and active involvement in Vermont 4-H at all levels. Ideally, the recipient can attend a presentation on 4-H day at ESE but if not (as many may already be at college), a representative may receive the award for them, which we can arrange.
