



Guest Tickets Information for the Commencement Ceremony for the Class of 2025

May 18, 2026, 3:00 P.M.

Ira Allen Chapel

Tickets will be available online for request by degree candidates only from Friday, March 28 – Thursday, May 1 at 12:00 P.M. (EDT). Each degree candidate is eligible to receive up to six tickets.

Who needs a ticket?

Degree candidates **do not** need a ticket to participate in the Larner College of Medicine Ceremony.

Anyone who is not a degree candidate will need a ticket. Guests will not be admitted without a ticket. All guests require a ticket, including children of all ages.

Larner College of Medicine Faculty who participate in the faculty procession do not need a ticket. Guest hooders who are not current Larner College of Medicine faculty will need a ticket.

Who can reserve tickets?

Only degree candidates can reserve tickets online. Guests seeking tickets must connect with their degree candidate. Degree candidates do not need a ticket to participate in the Larner College of Medicine Ceremony.

When can tickets be reserved?

Tickets may be reserved from Friday, March 28 – Thursday, May 1 at 12:00 noon (EDT).

How can tickets be reserved?

Larner College of Medicine degree candidates will receive an email from Academic_Ceremonies@uvm.edu in their **UVM email (NOT their MED.UVM.EDU)** account on **Friday, March 28**. The email will include a link to the University of Vermont University Tickets web page where they will be asked to log in with their UVM Net ID and password. Once logged in, degree candidates will be able to reserve their tickets and print them out at any time and/or send them to their family and friends.

How many tickets can be reserved?

Larner College of Medicine degree candidates may reserve up to 6 tickets each. Tickets cannot be duplicated. Guests will be required to have their tickets available at all times and will need them for entry, exit, and re-entry to the Ira Allen Chapel.

Guests without tickets may view the ceremony via livestream. A link to the livestream will be posted on the Commencement webpage.

What if I need more than 6 tickets?

If a degree candidate would like more than 6 tickets, additional tickets may be available (but are not guaranteed). Students may request to add up to two additional tickets via the wait list when requesting tickets. Please note that requesting additional tickets via the wait list is not a guarantee that you will be able to receive more than your original 6 tickets; it will get you on a wait list for additional tickets in the event there are leftover tickets after the initial reservation period. Additional tickets will be released on May 2, after the initial ticketing period has closed. If additional tickets are available, students who requested them will be notified via email when their tickets are ready to be claimed. Wait list tickets must be claimed within 24 hours. Unclaimed tickets will be released to others on the waitlist.
