

University of Vermont Department of Education 2025 Annual Report - Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation Measure 4 – Ability of Completers to be Hired in Education Positions for Which They Have Been Prepared

Employment data on program completers are collected directly by the University of Vermont through contact with former students. Information is gathered by UVM career outcome surveys and education department staff also use web and social media searches. There is no singular source of career data for program completers. Completers are defined as those who meet all requirements for licensure.

Post-completion data were collected for 68 of our 94 completers in 2024 (as of January 2025). The table below provides information on the hire rate of program completers in education positions. It also provides information on the rate of continuing education. 78% of the 68 completers for whom we were able to collect data were employed in education.
