Dear UVM community,

It is with great pleasure that we announce the hiring of Dr. Marlene Tromp as the 28th president of the University of Vermont, following unanimous approval at a special meeting of the Board of Trustees this afternoon.

Dr. Tromp's hiring follows a thorough national search in which the Presidential Search Advisory Committee on which we serve as co-chairs fielded more than 100 expressions of interest and selected more than 10 candidates to interview. From that robust process, Dr. Marlene Tromp emerged—someone whom we felt combined empathy and engagement with the community with deep leadership experience and proven ability to execute a strategic vision at this challenging time. It was important for the Search Advisory Committee and the Board to have an inclusive process through which we collected feedback and engaged on a continual basis with stakeholders throughout the campus community. The leader of UVM is also a vital leader for the community and state, and Dr. Tromp brings with her the experience and ability for great success that will benefit all three. Winner of the 2024 Pulitzer Prize and written by UVM graduate Ebony Booth, *Primary Trust* revolves around Kenneth, a tenderhearted man who spends his evenings sipping mai tais at the local bar. However, he faces an unknown world when the bookstore where he's worked for twenty years closes. Touching, hilarious, and wildly inventive, *Primary Trust* explores the power of small acts of kindness and Kenneth's courageous journey out of loneliness and into joyful self-discovery. *Primary Trust* runs from March 19 through April 6. Showtimes are Wednesday through Saturday evenings at 7:30 p.m., with Saturday and Sunday matinees at 2:00 p.m. at the Main Street Landing Performing Arts Center.
