and coaching focused on in-depth business plan development/implementation, enterprise analysis, financial and marketing planning.

UVM EXTENSION FOREST BUSINESS ROUNDTABLE

continues after a successful launch in 2021. This peer advisory cohort shares challenges and opportunities, hones business management skills, and develops leadership skills with a varied group of industry peers. This program includes:

- Monthly meetings with 10 to 12 business owners/ managers in an informal "board of directors" setting.
- Business skill and discipline exploration to learn from industry professionals, network with forest economy operators, develop relationships, and conduct business.

BUSINESS CLINICS

are short, focused meetings to review business plans, cash flow, loan applications, cost analysis, etc.
