- Bikes: Supply enough rentals for all requests, build more racks, grow the sharing system

- Outreach: Promote student attendance at SGA meetings, hold monthly town halls with President Tromp, encourage students to submit proposal petitions, build a student idea wall in the Galaxy Space, place mini mailboxes for student opinions and ideas in common spaces, allow for all students to be able to participate in student government affairs in a greater capacity and implement their ideas through their own projects

  send a monthly news email, record senator introduction
  videos, run a bi-weekly podcast with guests, develop a fresh
  website listing senator bios, project updates, idea submissions,
  participation opportunities, and event information
- Academics: Create more life-skills activities on finance, career, and health, work with students to increase classroom student voice, allow pitches for new class ideas, expand independent project-based-learning opportunities, develop new Learning Communities based on student interests data
