A Poetry Slam is a mash up of a public presentation and stage performance. It is intentionally engaging — capturing and maintaining the audience's attention. Performances must be original content, written and performed by the participant. The presentation may be on a phone/device, printed paper or notecards. It does not need to be memorized yet please rehearse your presentation so the notes are not just read. Each poetry slam performance must be 3–4 minutes in length. Consider using “poetry slam” candor, rhythm and emphasis on certain aspects. It doesn't have to be rhyming to be poetry! Below is the rubric used for judging. Read the comments to see suggestions to improve your presentation. **Thank you for hard work and efforts! *This will not Poetry Slam doesn't count against the Stage/Performance quota.**
