Why Army Medicine?

Programs Available

Health Professions Scholarship Program

- 1, 2, 3, or 4 year scholarship
- Pays for tuition, fees, and supplies
- \$20,000 bonus
- \$2,999 monthly stipend while in medical school
- 99% residency match rate

Medical Student Stipend Program

- Eligible during medical school
- Monthly stipend of \$2,999
- Part time obligation at the end of residency

Specialized Training Assistance Program

- Eligible anytime during residency
- Up to \$250,000 student loan repayment
- Monthly stipend of \$2,999
- Part time obligation at the end of residency

Financial Assistance Program

- Eligible after year 1 of GME internship
- Must have license to practice medicine
- Annual grant of \$45,000
- Monthly stipend of \$2,999
- Full time obligation at the end of residency
