SUMMARY OF PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES - OVERALL

I was hired in 2020 by the Department of Emergency Medicine with a secondary appointment in the Department of Pediatrics on the Clinician Scholar pathway to provide clinical care in the emergency department while developing a strong academic reputation for myself through rigorous clinical research regionally, nationally, and internationally. Although most of my efforts are on research pursuits, I remain steadfast in my commitment to clinical care, medical education, service, and advocacy for children. I have been honored with 10 awards related directly to clinical and local, regional, and national advocacy efforts. Further, I have published extensively on clinical topics in pediatric emergency medicine, with many incorporating trainees and colleagues outside the emergency department. I continue to move towards research independence through a National Institutes of Health (NIH) Career Development

Award (K23) earned in 2022, as well as two site directorships for NIH-funded multi-site studies. Overall, I have secured over \$1,000,000 in research funding since I became a faculty member and recently submitted an NIH R01 in June 2025. This is in addition to approximately 50 peer-reviewed scholarly publications, 70 national presentations, and more than 110 invited lectures on various clinical, educational, and research topics. I have received 6 awards specifically for research on the local and national level.

In both areas of my career as a clinician and researcher, I remain dedicated to teaching and active in the education of medical students, graduate trainees, and EM colleagues through bedside and didactic teaching opportunities. This includes participation in ongoing courses as well as numerous invited lectures on pediatric emergency medicine, research methodology, and healthcare leadership for medical students, trainees, and faculty. I have mentored 23 individuals ranging from undergraduate students to faculty. These mentorship efforts, which include several mentees underrepresented in medicine, continue to be extraordinarily productive. My mentees have presented and published widely, with 12 national and local poster presentations, 6 oral research presentations, 7 peer-reviewed publications, and 1 research award amongst them.

For service, I have held and hold multiple leadership positions in various local and national organizations, including the American Academy of Pediatrics Committee on Pediatric Emergency Medicine (appointed position), which is intended to be composed of national leaders in my field. I have also served on 6 national grant advisory panels, including 1 for the NIH as an early career reviewer and 4 for the CDC (including as Chair). Locally, I am a member of the faculty senate at UVM.

In sum, this productivity in my early career reflects my sincere passion to improve the healthcare landscape for vulnerable children and families locally, nationally, and internationally, with a specific focus on those who are most medically and socially at-risk.

- **Teaching:** Provided and continue to provide mentorship to 23 total undergraduate students, research associates, graduate students, medical student, medical trainees and faculty, which resulted in 12 national and local poster presentations, 6 oral research presentations, 7 peer - reviewed publications, and 1 research award.
- **Teaching:** Delivered approximately 106 invited local, national, and international presentations, with 5 grand rounds given locally, nationally, and internationally

Throughout medical school, residency, and fellowship, I was involved in multiple committees and task forces to improve clinical care, education, research, and advocacy at various institutions and medical centers. SUMMARY OF TEACHING ACTIVITIES

As a former teacher, I highly value the everyday interactions I have while a pediatric emergency medicine attending in the emergency department as well as scheduled courses and didactics. Throughout residency, fellowship, and my early career, I have continued actively being involved in bedside teaching and various formal presentations at my institution as documented above. I am also a selected member of the University of Vermont Larner College of Medicine Teaching Academy since 2020 and have mentored many learners ranging from undergraduate students to faculty in my first 5 years at UVM as faculty. Some pertinent highlights of my teaching include continual participation in the bedside teaching of trainees in pediatric emergency medicine, which is a high demand specialty in the emergency department for education and typically involves 1-4 learners per shift. The learners include medical students, residents (emergency medicine, pediatrics, family medicine), physician assistant students, and nurse practitioner students. UVMHC is the only site in the state of Vermont with pediatric emergency medicine specialists. Therefore, my colleagues and I are relied upon heavily to provide numerous learners with education at the bedside, and this is a source of pride and joy for myself and our small group of physicians. I also participate in the ongoing 4th year LCOM curriculum for medical students in the emergency department, including bedside teaching and workshops specifically for this group. For faculty, I recently became an organizer and lecturer in the UVM/Vermont Medical Society Physician Leadership Course, of which my focus is on how to run effective meetings in healthcare.

SUMMARY OF SCHOLARLY ACTIVITIES

The focus of my research is emergency care of children with medical complexity. Other pursuits include research on pediatric firearm injuries (as a leader of a national research

The transition to an independent investigator is ongoing as I submitted an NIH R01 in June 2025 proposing a multi - center randomized hybrid implementation effectiveness trial testing the emergency care action plan (ECAP) developed in the first two years of my K23 award.
