


VCHIP & VITL SHARED PLANS OF CARE PILOT

The **Vermont Child Health Improvement Program (VCHIP)** and **Vermont Information Technology Leaders (VITL)** are collaborating with several partners around Vermont to optimize technology to support the utilization and accessibility of care plans for children and youth with special health needs.

The pilot project supports pilot users in developing care plans (defined as a Shared Plan of Care, Asthma Action Plan, Seizure Action Plan or other identified care plan), with patients and families, within their current Electronic Health Record. The pilot user then uploads a PDF copy of the Shared Plan of Care (SPoC) to VITLAccess where it is categorized as appropriate. Other VITLAccess users would be able to access the uploaded document within VITLAccess as needed.



While sharing data through VITL is not a new concept, allowing VITL data contributors*, who are recognized pilot users, to manually upload care plans into VITLAccess is a new functionality. This aims to improve communication, reduce care gaps, reduce redundancies, and improve patient and care team satisfaction. Uploaded care plans will be accessible for viewing in VITLAccess*, allowing care partners across organizations and care settings to view care recommendations more efficiently.



THIS PILOT PROCESS IS NOT THE END GOAL (WE WON'T BE MANUALLY UPLOADING PLANS FOREVER) BUT A STEP ALONG THE WAY TO TRUE INTEROPERABILITY OF CARE PLAN DATA. PARTICIPANTS WILL HELP US LEARN ABOUT WHAT'S WORKING NOW, EVALUATE NEW APPROACHES, AND HELP DEFINE FUTURE NEEDS FOR TECHNOLOGY TO SUPPORT PERSON-CENTERED CARE PLANNING
