An excellent photo based graphic design should have a center of interest and should tell a story or have a message. Photograph must be altered by a minimum of two photo manipulation techniques that transform the image into something completely different. Designer must use a design program like Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign, etc. to embellish, alter or fix and original image and/or physical manipulation of elements (as opposed to digital) is allowed. In addition, choose and include at least two of the following required graphic design elements: letters or words, shapes, lines, colors and/or textures. Photos must be the original work of the 4-H'er and have been created in the 12 months preceding this 4-H event. Maximum size of the work is 8" x 10" (mat, if used, can be up to 11" x 17"). **A before photo must be included to provide a basis for comparison.** Artistic elements to consider include composition, use of space, color, shapes, words and photographs to create a balanced piece that conveys a clear message. Below you will find an evaluator's opinion of the effectiveness of your design. Read their comments to see what they think would improve your work. **Thank you for exhibiting your work!**
