This list represents research relating to the University of Vermont's East Woods Natural Area. Purchased in 1949, East Woods is one of the 11 Natural Areas owned by the University. The woods are relatively quiet, and are used for recreation and limited research. It is the site of an interpretive trail, which was installed in 1986. The forest also contains Potash Brook, the location around which the most concentrated research efforts are centered.

The documents listed below are those which pertain to scholarly research and management reports undertaken in the Area.
